RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Iowa State Fair Management reserves to its Board the final and absolute right to interpret these Rules and Regulations, as well as Iowa State Fair Administrative Rules (available at the Manager's Office), and settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of, connected with, or incident to the Fair. Exhibitors failing to comply with any of these rules are subject to all premium cancellations.
2. Breed-specific rules and regulations are outlined in their respective section of this Premium Book. Exhibitors are required to read ALL rules and procedures which pertain to the division they are entering. In the event of conflict of general and special rules, the latter will govern. **Exhibitors are required to read these rules and regulations and be prepared to comply with them.**
3. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations will be decided by the Horse Show Management, whose decision shall be final. Direct all questions and inquiries to the Iowa State Fair Horse Department at 515-262-3111, ext. 241 or e-mail at horse@iowastatefair.org.
4. **NO PETS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.** The sale of dogs, cats or other pets is prohibited.
5. **NO GOLF CARTS OF ANY TYPE ARE PERMITTED**, except for official Iowa State Fair carts.
6. There will be no unauthorized use of utilities on the Fairgrounds.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

7. **SUBMITTING ENTRIES.** Entries **must be submitted online** at <https://www.iowastatefair.org/>.
8. **ENTRY DEADLINE IS JULY 1. ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE ON OR BEFORE JULY 1.** Entries submitted July 2 - July 8 will be charged a late fee of \$10 per head. No entries will be accepted after July 8. (Exception: Draft Horses - see Draft Horse rules.) Horses and ponies entered in the show by July 8 may enter other classes for which they are eligible in their division by paying the class entry fees.
9. Each exhibitor, as a requirement for entry, will pay an entry fee. **Entry Fee must accompany entry or it will be returned.**
10. There will be a \$20 charge for each returned check and issuer could be liable for up to three times the amount of the check. **Cash, cashiers check or money order will be required if a check is returned for insufficient funds. All insufficient fund checks must be cleared before October 15. If such checks are not cleared by October 15, these exhibitors may enter future Fairs only on a cash basis and must include payment of funds past due.**
11. No refunds of fees will be made unless cancellation is received **IN WRITING** (letter or e-mail) by July 21. **REFUNDS FOR VET-OUTS WILL NOT BE ISSUED IF RECEIVED AFTER JULY 21.** No refunds will be given on tickets, wristbands or vehicle permits. No refunds of \$10 or less will be issued. Refunds will be made by mail after the close of the Fair (separate from premium checks).
12. All entries for the Iowa State Fair must be made in the **NAME OF THE OWNER OR LESSEE** with all horses to be named. Should any individual enter an animal in a name other than that of a bona fide owner or attempt to perpetrate a fraud by misrepresenting any fact, the entry shall not be allowed to compete for or receive any premium. In case of question as to the age of an animal, the Superintendent shall appoint an expert whose decision shall be final.
13. Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entries. Entries that have been erroneously entered may, at the discretion of the Superintendent of the department, be transferred to their proper classes previous to the judging. If such classes have been judged they shall not be re-judged.
14. **The Management reserves the right to return any entries received beyond the capacity of the facilities offered.**
15. The Iowa State Fair reserves the right to refuse entry of any exhibitor who has been barred from any fair or livestock show holding membership in the International Association of Fairs and Expositions on the basis of unethical practices, violation of drug residue avoidance programs, or violation of any Show rules. The Iowa State Fair reserves the right to refuse entry of any exhibitor who is listed on the U.S. Center for SafeSport Centralized Disciplinary Database.
16. **No exhibitor will be allowed to run a tab.** Any fees not paid upon completion of the show will cause the exhibitor to forfeit all premiums won and be denied future participation in the Iowa State Fair Horse Shows.
17. The Horse Show Office in the Horse Barn will open approximately one hour before the morning show and will close one hour prior to each evening show. Exhibitors must pick up show packets, correct any pending items, make additional entries, scratches or handler changes prior to the scheduled session in which they are entered. The Show Office **MUST** be notified promptly of any entry cancellations or changes.
18. As an Iowa State Fair exhibitor, I hereby acknowledge that my photograph may be taken by the official Iowa State Fair photographer for use by the Iowa State Fair and agree to release and hold harmless the State of Iowa, Iowa State Fair Authority, their officers, employees and agents and any and all parties to whom this or any photograph may be released. This photograph was taken for artistic reasons or newsworthiness and I agree that it may be released to any medium and may be used in any manner for any purpose whatsoever without compensation.

PREMISES IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

19. Premises Identification Numbers are not mandatory to exhibit livestock (beef, dairy, horses, swine*, sheep, goats, poultry and rabbits) at the 2026 Iowa State Fair.

Producers who choose to register their premises will be better informed to protect their premises and their livelihood. In turn, they will help prevent disease spread and minimize the economic damage of an animal disease outbreak or animal health event. Registering a premise involves obtaining a seven-character alpha-numeric "identifier" for the farm, ranch, veterinary clinic or other site where livestock or fowl are handled, housed, managed or processed.

When including the Premises ID number on entry forms, please use the identifier for the location where the animal is primarily housed.

If an exhibitor wants to register their premises, an application form can be found on-line at www.iowaagriculture.gov/animalindustry.asp. An application can also be obtained by calling 888-778-7675. The application process may take up to 4 weeks to receive the number.

* Premises ID Number(s) must be provided on entry forms to participate in the Open Market Swine Show.

ADMISSION/PARKING

20. **All exhibitors are required to pay admission.** Discounted admission tickets at \$11 (adults) or \$7 (children 6-11 years old) per day are available to purchase when making entry. Additional tickets may also be purchased through the Entry Department. Admission tickets will be mailed in late July or early August. Without admission tickets, the full price of \$16 (adults) and \$10 (children) per day will be charged at the gate. Tickets will not be sold in the Horse Barn Office.
21. **No vehicles or trailers will be permitted around the barns, except while unloading and loading.** Any exhibitor reported being in this area for an extended period of time will be towed at the owner's expense and forfeit any premiums won.
22. **Each exhibitor will be given one unload permit. Additional unload permits are available upon request. This permit allows a maximum of 30 minutes to unload animals and tack but does not provide parking or admission.**

23. **VEHICLE PERMITS.** Each exhibitor may purchase a vehicle parking permit at \$10 per day. Each exhibitor is limited to two Fairgrounds lot permits per day. Vehicle permits must be purchased in advance by indicating the specific days needed on the Entry Form. Each vehicle permit will park one car or truck (no trailers) in a Fairgrounds lot for the specified day(s). Vehicle permits are required to park in Fairgrounds lots on a space available basis. Parking will not be available at the gate.
24. A special parking lot for livestock trailers and semis (tractor & trailer) is located approximately three blocks south of the Fairgrounds. You will be directed to the lot by Livestock Control.
25. If vehicles are illegally parked, they will be towed at owners' expense.
26. Camping overnight in parking lots on the Fairgrounds is prohibited. Curfew will be called at 1:00 a.m. daily and from that time until 5:00 a.m., only those persons with business may remain on the Fairgrounds (including owners or caretakers of exhibits, guards, persons registered at dormitories, Fair officials and employees).
27. For nonresident truck and trailer permits, reciprocity and trip permits visit the Iowa Department of Transportation website at www.iowadot.gov.

STALLING

28. Arrival and departure times for each breed are listed in their respective section of this Premium Book. Horses must be in place and are not released until the dates and times designated.
29. **All horses must be stalled. No tying or tethering in aisles will be allowed.** Stall fees are \$25 per stall. Due to limited barn space, stalls will be assigned in order received to barn capacity. After the barns are filled, entries will be returned.
30. **Stalling requests must be stated in the space available on the Horse Entry Form and all involved parties must state the request.** The Barn Manager will have the stall assignments for the exhibitors upon their arrival to the Fairgrounds. No exhibitors may switch stalls without the knowledge and consent of the Barn Manager.
31. All horses brought on to the Iowa State Fairgrounds are to be entered and shown in a minimum of one class. In the case of a mare and foal, at least one of the two must be entered and shown. Owners/exhibitors found to violate this rule (unless the animal is excused by an Iowa State Fair Veterinarian) will forfeit all premiums and be placed on probation with the Iowa State Fair.
32. The Iowa State Fair strongly encourages exhibitors to share tack stalls if possible. Please note requests on entry forms. If the demand for stalls exceeds availability, the number of tack stalls requested will be reviewed for reasonableness based on number of head entered.
33. Straw and woodchips/shavings are the only allowable bedding. These will be available for purchase on the Fairgrounds. Feed Barn hours are 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
34. It is suggested that all exhibitors decorate their stalls in an attractive manner. No alteration of stalls will be permitted. The space in front of the stall **must** be kept clean of all debris.
35. **All stalls must be cleaned before 8:00 a.m. each morning.**
36. No smoking will be permitted in any barn on the Iowa State Fairgrounds. This will be strongly enforced.

VET OFFICE

37. Exhibitors will be responsible for taking their animals' current health certificates to the Veterinary Office for approval prior to picking up exhibitor packets in the Horse Barn Office. The Veterinary Office hours will be: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., August 11-23. Please schedule your arrival to give yourself ample time to go to the Veterinary Office for checking of health certificates.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES NOT COMPLETED PROPERLY WILL BE DENIED AND THE OWNER WILL BE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A NEW CERTIFICATE AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

Falsifying or tampering with a health certificate is a federal and state offense and will be grounds for disqualification and removal of all animals listed on the health certificate. (Iowa Code 163.18 and 163.24) Official State Fair Veterinarians are available to inspect animals and complete health certificates if a problem develops.

2026 HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE EXHIBITION OF LIVESTOCK, POULTRY AND BIRDS AT THE IOWA STATE FAIR

SECTION 1 - GENERAL

- A. All animals, poultry and birds intended for exhibition within the State of Iowa will be considered under quarantine and not eligible for showing until the owner or agent presents a CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION, stating the animals, poultry or birds are apparently free from symptoms of infectious or communicable diseases as determined on clinical inspection by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days (14 days for sheep and 7 days for swine) prior to date of entry to exhibition grounds.
- B. **Please Note** (Veterinarian and Exhibitor): The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must include the name of the owner or exhibitor and 911 address of the site the animal(s) reside, the name and 911 address of the exhibition, and shall only be used for one exhibition.
- C. INDIVIDUAL CERTIFICATES OF VETERINARY INSPECTION WILL NOT BE REQUIRED in certain classes if the division superintendent has made prior arrangements with the official fair veterinarian to have all animals and/or birds inspected on arrival and prior to exhibition.

ANY EVIDENCE OF WARTS, RINGWORM, FOOT ROT, PINK EYE, DRAINING ABSCESSSES, OR ANY OTHER CONTAGIOUS DISEASE WILL ELIMINATE THE ANIMAL FROM THE SHOW.

SECTION 7 - HORSES AND MULES

All horses shall be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection with individual identification, or a description of the individual animal. These requirements apply to all horses entering the fairgrounds.

Native Iowa horses and mules can be exhibited when accompanied by an individual Certificate of Veterinary Inspection listing a description of the individual animals.

All equine originating from outside the state shall be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection listing a description of the individual animals; and indicating that each animal six months of age and older in the shipment has had a negative official equine infectious anemia test within twelve months of importation. The testing laboratory, accession number, and date of test must appear on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, or a copy of the Coggins (EIA) test paper must be presented.

38. **No injections or medications may be given to a horse without an Official Iowa State Fair Veterinarian being present.** Veterinarians will be looking for drug abuse or physical cruelty to animals in the show and will, upon proper evidence, bar any horse from showing. Breed show and contest rules on abuse, when available, will be followed. Any dispute as to age, height or soundness of horses will be referred to the Official Veterinarian, and his decision will be final.

39. THE IOWA STATE FAIR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RANDOMLY TEST ANY ANIMAL FOR DRUGS/ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES.
40. An official farrier will NOT be on duty. Exhibitors may use a farrier of their own choice.

GENERAL SHOW RING REGULATIONS

41. The exercise schedule for the Jacobson Exhibition Center, Livestock Pavilion and the Outdoor Arena will be at the discretion of the Horse Show Management.
42. The 2-minute rule will be observed following class call.
43. Horse Show Management reserves the right to cancel any class where there are less than five entries.
44. Exhibitors shall wear the correct identifying number properly displayed to the satisfaction of the Horse Show Management.
45. Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience by them, their riders, drivers, grooms or agents to the Judges, Officials or Staff shall forfeit all premiums won at the show and may be asked to leave the Fairgrounds. Horse Show Management shall have full power to act in issuing a ruling in such cases (i.e. denying participation at future Iowa State Fair Horse Shows).
46. All attendants must be suitably and neatly dressed when entering the ring to show or assist in the showing of horses. It is the tradition of the show ring that an exhibitor is correctly attired for the class in question and that attendants are neatly and properly presented. The Management may, at its discretion, bar an entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably attired before the public, without claim or damage. No person other than the Officials and exhibitors will be admitted to the show ring during a class. One header per horse may enter the ring at the directions of the announcer. The header should be dressed neatly and appropriately for the show.

ADMISSION TO JACOBSON EXHIBITION CENTER

47. No admission will be charged for any horse shows held during the Iowa State Fair.

PREMIUMS

48. Premium checks in all departments will be paid as soon after the close of the Fair as possible. Since the Iowa State Fair fiscal year ends in October, any discrepancies in the amounts of premium checks must be called to our attention before October 15. No claims for error after that date can be honored.
49. The Iowa State Fair Board is pleased to list special premiums and awards in the Premium Book, but will not be responsible for their payment or delivery unless they have been received by the Competitive Events Director by opening day of the Fair.
50. Special prizes will not be accepted for classes that do not conform to the regular classifications of the department in which they are offered unless for reasons satisfactory to the Executive Committee and the Superintendent of the department in which they are offered.
51. When there is only one exhibitor in a class, the first prize, if merited, will be awarded. When animals are not worthy of first prize, judges may, at their discretion, award a prize or prizes of such grade as the animals merit. When there is competition, all prizes may be awarded so far as there are worthy entries. If two entries are equal, both place monies are to be totaled and divided equally.
52. The Iowa State Fair is required to report payments of \$600 or more to the Internal Revenue Service. Any exhibitor receiving \$600 or more will be required to provide the Iowa State Fair with a completed IRS Form W-9 providing a taxpayer identification number. These exhibitors will be sent a form from the Iowa State Fair Competitive Events Department. The exhibitor's premium check will be mailed after a completed W-9 has been returned to the Competitive Events Department.

FANS, OTHER ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES & EXTENSION CORDS

53. All fans, electrical appliances and extension cords used in the livestock barns or dormitories must include a ground, must have safe wiring and must be in safe operating condition. All fans used in livestock barns or dormitories must have a protective screen (front and back). Only one fan per animal will be allowed. The use of butt fans is prohibited in all barns. For Beef and Dairy Cattle only overhead fans located in the front half of stalling area will be allowed. No air duct apparatuses will be permitted. If any and all persons participating in any and all events governed by this Premium Book are in doubt concerning the acceptability of their fan, other electrical appliance or extension cord they should consult the Superintendent. Any and all persons participating in any and all events covered by this Premium Book hereby acknowledge the following:
 - A. The Superintendent has the express authority to determine if any fan, other electrical appliance or extension cord complies with this rule.
 - B. Should the Superintendent determine that a fan, other electrical appliance or extension cord does not comply with this provision; the Superintendent has the express authority to require that use of the fan, other electrical appliance or extension cord be immediately discontinued.
 - C. Failure to comply with this provision in a timely manner shall be grounds for immediate dismissal from continued participation in the Fair and the forfeiture of all entry fees, charges, ribbons, Championships and premiums awarded.
 - D. Any and all persons participating in any and all events covered by this Premium Book are responsible for performing all steps necessary to assure that any fans, other electrical appliances and extension cords are in good repair and free of dangerous conditions or defects. Pursuant to the provision of this Premium Book the Fair may, but has no duty to do so, determine if any fan, other electrical appliance or extension cord meets these requirements established in this portion of this Premium Book.

TIE RINGS & BEDDING

54. Any and all persons participating in any and all events governed by this Premium Book acknowledge the following:
 - A. If applicable, said participants must tie their animal(s) in the tie ring(s) furnished by the Iowa State Fair.
 - B. The use of paper bedding is prohibited in the Iowa State Fair's barns.
 - C. Failure to comply with this provision in a timely manner shall be grounds for immediate dismissal from continued participation in the Fair and the forfeiture of all entry fees, charges, ribbons, Championships and premiums awarded.

LIABILITY

55. Every horse or pony entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, and every precaution will be taken to protect the property of the exhibitor. The Horse Show Management and the Iowa State Fair will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show Management, the Iowa State Fair and State of Iowa blameless for any loss or accident to his/her horse (or caused by his/her horse) or equipment which may occur from sickness, accident, fire or otherwise.

NEW BREEDS IN COMPETITION

56. The Iowa State Fair Board must approve the breed association's application for a specific breed show. A breed showing for the first time at the Iowa State Fair must show for two years and have at least 35 head, 25 of which must be from Iowa, and a minimum of five exhibitors. During these two years, the sponsoring breed association pays the premiums. The Iowa State Fair provides the judge, ribbons and banners.

BREED PROBATION

57. To place an established breed of livestock on probation the following shall apply:
- A. Any breed of livestock on the show schedule for the Iowa State Fair shall maintain a three-year rolling average of at least two separate Iowa breeder/farms and 30 head shown during the Fair. Should the breed fall below this average, a letter of probation shall be sent by the Competitive Events Director of the Fair to both the state president of the breed association and the national headquarters of the breed.
 - B. During the first probation year the Fair shall deduct 25% of the offered premiums by the Fair. If during this probation year the breed does not show a minimum of two separate Iowa breeders/farms and 30 head, the breed shall be disqualified from showing at the Iowa State Fair beginning the following year. Should the breed during this probation year show at least the minimum head/breeders required, the three-year rolling average shall be computed. If that average is still below the minimum requirement, the breed shall be placed on a second year of probation with an additional 25% of the offered premiums by the Fair from the previous year deducted. At the end of the second consecutive year of probation, the breed must meet the three-year rolling average or be eliminated from being a recognized Iowa State Fair breed. Should a breed that has been placed on the first year of probation raise its three-year rolling average to the minimum head/breeder requirement, the breed shall be reinstated to full premiums and removed from probation for the following year. After elimination from the show schedule, the breed shall have the opportunity to re-introduce the breed through the exhibition process.
 - C. The Iowa State Fair shall provide a judge for any livestock show held during the annual Iowa State Fair.
 - D. The same entry fees shall be paid by all livestock exhibitors regardless of show status.
 - E. The Iowa State Fair Board reviewed and recommended approval to freeze the probation status of **Draft Pony** and **Farm Team** at full premiums for one year.

PROTESTS

58. Protests - Disciplinary Action. Any and all participants in any and all events described in this Premium Book hereby acknowledge that they are voluntarily agreeing to participate in said event. Any and all participants in any and all events covered by this Premium Book hereby expressly acknowledge in a knowing and informed manner that the participant has no constitutional or statutory right to participate or compete in any and all events covered by this Premium Book and that the participant shall abide by and is subject to all rules and procedures applicable to the event entered as stated in this Premium Book. Any and all participants in any and all events covered by this Premium Book hereby expressly acknowledge the following as an express condition of their voluntary decision to participate in any and all events covered by this Premium Book:

Any and all participants in any and all events covered by this Premium Book hereby acknowledge and expressly agree that the procedures and remedies set out in this Premium Book shall be the exclusive procedures and remedies available to any and all participants concerning any decision or action taken by the Fair on any protest, discipline or complaint in any and all events covered by this Premium Book.
 - C. Any and all participants in any and all events covered by this Premium Book expressly acknowledge and expressly agree that they will have the burden of going forward and the burden of proof concerning the establishment of the grounds for any protest, discipline or complaint brought under the provisions of this Premium Book.
 - 1. Any and all participants in any and all events covered by this Premium Book shall have 24 hours from the conclusion of the show involving the class in question to file any protests, challenges of disciplinary action or complaints brought under the provisions of this Premium Book which involve any issue other than the results of drug testing.

Deposit must be filed with Fair Board Secretary contemporaneously with any and all protests, challenges of disciplinary action or complaints.
 - 6. The Competition Committee of the State Fair Board shall consider any protests, challenges of disciplinary action or complaints filed pursuant to this paragraph as speedily as possible and their decision may be appealed exclusively using the appeal procedure set out in paragraph 59 of this Premium Book.
 - D. The Iowa State Fair Board shall only consider protests, challenges of disciplinary action or complaints filed by a Participant entered in the same Department as the Participant that is the subject of the protest, challenge of disciplinary action or complaint.

have the burden of going forward and the burden of proof concerning the establishment of the grounds for any appeal brought under the provisions of this Premium Book.

- D. Specific procedures for appeals concerning positive drug tests or questions of animal identification are set out in board policy which are available upon request. These procedures are incorporated by reference herein.

The appeal procedures are as follows:

1. Any and all participants in any and all events covered by this Premium Book shall have 10 days from the entrance of a decision of the Competition Committee concerning any protests, challenges of disciplinary action or complaints brought under the provisions of this Premium Book to file an appeal of said decision.
2. The Iowa State Fair will not consider any appeal based upon the statement that a judge or judges are incompetent.
3. Any and all appeals of any decision of the Competition Committee concerning any protests, challenges of disciplinary action or complaints brought under the provisions of this Premium Book shall be in writing and shall be filed with Fair Board Secretary within the above-referenced time period(s).
4. Any and all appeals of any decision of the Competition Committee concerning any protests, challenges of disciplinary action or complaints brought under the provisions of this Premium Book shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$250 which will be forfeited if the appeal is not sustained. Deposit must be filed with Fair Board Secretary contemporaneously with any and all appeals.
5. The State Fair Board shall consider any and all appeals of any decision of the Competition Committee concerning any protests, challenges of disciplinary action or complaints brought under the provisions of this Premium Book filed pursuant to this paragraph as speedily as possible and their decision in the matter shall be final. In considering appeals from the Competition Committee the Board may follow the procedures set forth in 371 Iowa Administrative Code 1.3(3).

The Iowa State Fair accepts no responsibility for entries not received.
3. Two club or association officers are required to sign the entry form. Forms without BOTH signatures will be voided. **The persons signing the entry form as club representatives shall not be immediate family members of the contestant or the contestant herself.** Club officials' daytime phone numbers and/or e-mail address must accompany the entry.
4. Clubs or associations who misrepresent a contestant's age will be barred from future sponsorship. Persons who misrepresent a club or association will be barred from future participation in Cowgirl Queen Contests.
5. No stallions are allowed in the Cowgirl Queen Contest.

2. **ENTRY DEADLINE IS JULY 1.** Entries must be submitted online on or before **July 1.** Entries submitted July 2 - July 8 will be charged a late fee of \$10 per head. Entries submitted July 9 - August 1 will be charged a late fee of \$40 per head. No entries will be accepted after August 1. Horses entered in the show by August 1 may enter other classes for which they are eligible in their division by paying the class entry fees.
3. **FEES.** Stall fees are \$25 per stall. Class fees are listed per class.
4. All horses entered in purebred line classes (including all Champion classes) must be registered with their respective breed associations. Exhibitors must furnish copies of their registration papers to Show Management (with the exception of grade classes 101A and 901A).
5. A horse **must** be shown in its respective halter class to show in the group class.
6. The exhibitor, as defined by entity, individual or farm assigned the exhibitor number displayed during the class, **MUST OWN** at least four of the horses that are hitched for their entry in any six horse hitch class.
7. Any hitch showing in a Classic Six-Horse Hitch Series Points Qualifying Class (classes 161, 162, 962, and 990) must be a current paid member of the NASHHCS. Show passes were discontinued by the NASHHCS in 2025. Please see <https://naclassicseries.com/bylaws/> for further details.
8. **EXHIBITOR MEETING:** Prior to the start of the show on Sunday, a meeting for all exhibitors is held with show staff to provide information regarding schedule, policies and procedures, answer questions and conduct drawings for heat assignments where needed. The exact meeting time and location will be announced on Sunday morning. Any exhibitor participating in a driving class (youth included, cart drivers on up) must have the driver or a designated representative present. All other exhibitors are highly encouraged to attend or send a representative.

AMERICAN SHIRE HORSE ASSOCIATION NATIONAL SHOW ELIGIBILITY RULES

- A. Shire stallions, mares and geldings registered with the American Shire Horse Association, the Canadian Shire Horse Association or the Shire Horse Society are eligible to show in registered classes. "Notified Colts" that are parentage verified and recorded in the name of the exhibitor are eligible to show.
- B. To be eligible to participate in ASHA National and Regional shows, animals must be registered with ASHA or registered and parentage verified in the country where they and their owners reside.
- C. Foals must be registered.
- D. Horses must be entered by the owner(s) listed on the horse's registration paper. Show entry forms usually list this as the 'exhibitor' or 'entrant'. Persons acting as agent or handler for the horse being shown may not be listed as the exhibitor/entrant. The owner does not have to be the person showing the horse. Leased horses may be entered by the leaser as recorded by the respective associations.
- E. Mares registered as 3/4 and 7/8 Shire may be shown with full registered mares. Geldings registered as 3/4, 7/8 or 15/16 Shire may be shown with full registered geldings.
- F. Geldings must be registered with a recognized Shire registry to be eligible for championships, best of breed or supreme champion titles, as well as premier points.
- G. Geldings that are not registered must be of Shire type to show in a grade gelding class.
- H. When a horse registered with SHS or CHSA (but not with ASHA) is entered, a copy of the registration paper must be sent to the ASHA Secretary in order to allow verification of eligibility.
- I. All horses shown in group classes must be registered (get, produce, mare and foal, herd).
- J. Copies of registration papers, showing the exhibitor as owner, must be presented to the ASHA Show coordinator for ALL late or post entered horses before they may be shown.

1. Please read Iowa State Fair Rules and Procedures in the front of this Premium Book.
2. **ENTRY DEADLINE IS JULY 1.** Entries must be submitted online on or before **July 1.** Entries submitted July 2 - July 8 will be charged a late fee of \$10 per head. No entries will be accepted after July 8. Horses entered in the show by July 8 may enter other classes for which they are eligible in their division by paying the class entry fees.
3. **FEES.** Stall fees are \$25 per stall. Class fees are listed per class.
4. No association memberships are required
5. Exhibitors must have health papers for their horse upon arrival at the Fair. No exceptions will be made.
6. Each horse will be issued one back number regardless of the number of classes entered or the number of exhibitors showing that horse.
7. No stallions allowed in any classes.
8. One class fee pays for entry under both judges. It is not an option to only enter under one judge. Prize money will be awarded under both judges. Ribbons will be awarded to those placing under both judges.
9. Riders shall wear Western hat and cowboy boots. Spurs are optional. Horses shown with a stock saddle. There shall be no discrimination against any type of standard western bit, but no hackamore bit or other device shall be allowed. A curb, halfbreed or spade bit is permissible; martingale or tie down is prohibited. No wire chain, or other metal, or rawhide device may be used in conjunction with, or as part of the leather chin strap. Curb chains may be used, at least an inch wide and flat. Riders will show with one hand on reins (except for Jr. Horse, 5 years and younger which may be shown in bosals and snaffle bits).
10. Horses in color breed halter class must be one of these – Paint, Appaloosa, Pinto, Buckskin, Roan or Dun.
11. A horse may be shown in only one of these halter classes – 40, 41, 42.
12. Eligibility for age-restricted classes is determined by the age of the exhibitor as of January 1 of the year of the contest.
13. Ranch Horse classes:
 - No horse may cross enter a western pleasure or walk/trot western pleasure and ranch riding class.
 - No hoof polish. No braided or banded manes/tails or tail extensions. Trimming inside the ears is discouraged. Trimming bridle path, fetlocks or excessive (long) facial hair is allowed.
 - Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit. Excessive silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged.
 - It is suggested competitors use a breast collar and rear cinch.
 - When exhibiting in a snaffle bit or hackamore, an exhibitor may switch between two hands and one hand on the reins at any time.
14. Exhibitor/horse combos can ride in Ranch and corresponding classes if they are not offered in Ranch. For example, a horse could go in Ranch Riding and Hunter Under Saddle.
