RULES

1. Open Class Livestock general rules, regulations and health requirements apply in this department. In case general rules conflict with Llama Department general or special rules, the latter shall govern. This show is also governed by the ILR Show Division guidelines.
2. **SUBMITTING ENTRIES.** Entries **must be made online** at <https://www.iowastatefair.org/>. **Llama registration information must be listed on the entry form. Unnamed entries will not be accepted.**
3. **ENTRY DEADLINE IS JULY 1. ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ON OR BEFORE JULY 1.**
4. **ENTRY FEES.** Each exhibitor, as a requirement for entry, will pay an entry fee of \$15 per animal and \$5 per class. **Entry Fee must accompany entry or it will be returned.**
5. **LATE ENTRIES.** Entries submitted July 2 - July 8 will be charged a late fee of \$10 per head in addition to regular entry fees. No entries will be accepted after July 8. Entries are accepted according to earliest postmark. Llamas entered in the show by July 8 may enter other classes for which they are eligible by paying the class entry fees at check-in.
6. **REFUNDS.** No refunds of fees will be made unless cancellation is received **IN WRITING** (letter or e-mail) by July 21. No refunds will be given on tickets, wristbands or vehicle permits. No refunds of \$10 or less will be issued. Refunds will be made by mail after the close of the Fair (separate from premium checks).
7. **ADMISSION TO THE FAIR.** Each exhibitor must purchase two discounted admission tickets at \$11 each when making entry. Additional tickets may be purchased. Discounted tickets for children 6-11 years old may be purchased for \$7 each. Without admission tickets, the full price of \$16 (adults) and \$10 (children) per day will be charged at the gate.
8. **UNLOAD PERMITS.** Each exhibitor will be given one unload permit. **This permit allows a maximum of 30 minutes to unload animals and tack but does not provide parking.**
9. **VEHICLE PERMITS.** Each exhibitor may purchase a vehicle parking permit at \$10 per day. Each exhibitor is limited to two Fairgrounds lot permits per day. Vehicle permits must be purchased in advance by indicating the specific days needed on the Entry Form. Each vehicle permit will park one car or truck (no trailers) in a Fairgrounds lot for the specified day(s). Vehicle permits are required to park in Fairgrounds lots on a space available basis. Parking will not be available at the gate.
10. **Additional ILR Show Division fees: All exhibitors must pay \$3 per animal for ILR Show Manager Fee.**
11. **Animals with pending ILR numbers at time of entry MUST have registration papers turned in at time of check in or the animal will be disqualified. No animal will be shown without a valid ILR number. Failure to meet this requirement prohibits entry in the show.**
12. Llamas may be entered in more than one class. **However, a llama can go through the course only one time in Freestyle, Obstacle, Trail/Pack, and PR/Companion classes. Animals can not show in both Adult and Youth Performance classes.**
13. The "Sub-Junior" classes are for persons ages 4 to 6. **No class entry fee - No premium! Participation ribbons only.** One "Spotter" per animal will be allowed in the ring during the class. Class will not be placed. Judged as a Showmanship Class and Obstacle Class.
14. **HALTER CLASSES.** Classes will be divided into Suri, Silky, Classic/Light, Medium and Heavy wool classes. Wool classes may be combined. See ILR website (www.lamaregistry.com) for wool descriptions.
15. **FUN CLASSES.** Entry fee is \$5 per class and can be entered up until entering the show ring.
16. **YOUTH.** The age division in which the youth will show will be determined by their age on January 1st of that year, however, if a youth reaches the age of 7 any time during the year, they will be eligible to show as of their birth date. When a senior youth reaches their 20th birthday, they are no longer eligible to show in the youth division at all.
17. **PREMIUMS.** Premiums will be awarded as follows in each class (excluding Sub-Junior and Championship): \$30, 20, 10, Ribbon, Ribbon. Ribbons only in Sub-Junior classes. Rosettes to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.
18. Grand and Reserve Performance Champions in each age level will be awarded ribbons.
19. **Best of Show Female** will be selected from the Grand Champion females in Suri, Silky, Classic/Light, Medium and Heavy wool divisions. **Best of Show Male** will be selected from the Grand Champion males in Suri, Silky, Classic/Light, Medium, Heavy and Non-Breeders divisions. A banner will be awarded to the Best of Show Female and the Best of Show Male.

Youth age division is determined by their age as of January 1st.

Class number represents show order.
