Christmas Tree Ornament

Beginning Crochet

\$25 Join Tasha for a learn to crochet make and take class. In this class students will learn how to make a chain and single crochet. With these basic stitches many wonderful pieces can be made and the knowledge gained can be used to master other crochet techniques and stitches. If time allows other stitches will be taught. Best for participants aged 14 and above. One-and-a-half-hour class.

Beginning Embroidery

\$40 Join Amanda with Prairie Rose Needleworks for an introduction to embroidery. Create an adorable sheep embroidery sampler utilizing many different stitches and techniques. Two-hour class.

Learn to Knit

\$15 Join members of the Des Moines Knitting Guild for a learn to knit make and take class. Learn how to knit the basic knit stitch and read a pattern to create a mug mat or cell phone case. Two-hour class.

ASG Zip Baa

\$20 Join members of the American Sewing Guild to make a zipper bag. This teaches skills that are transferable to garment sewing such as linings and zippers. You will leave class with a fun completed project. Two-hour class.

Hexagon Panel Table Topper

\$30 Come learn the basics of making a Hexagon Panel Table topper that utilizes six panels to make the pieced hexagons that create the color flow around a seventh uncut panel. Two-hour class. (limit of 8 participants)

Intro to Tattina

\$25 In this class you will learn the ONE and only stitch in tatting. It takes two movements to make the stitch. The 'lace' is made by manipulating the stitch. It is how the stitch/es are manipulated that makes a project. A shuttle and thread will be furnished. Two-hour class.

Beginner-Friendly Creative Hand Stitching \$39 Try your hand at creative stitching with this lovely customized quilt label project! The class kit includes a panel of several pre-printed quilt labels featuring elegant floral lines. We will learn the six most prominent embroidery stitches used in creative needlework to embellish and personalize quilt labels. In this beginner-friendly 2-hour class, participants can expect to learn several decorative stitches and will go home with a panel of several more quilt labels to continue stitching. What a wonderful way to personally customize your hand-made gifts!

Summer Blooms Needle Keeper Stitch up a little garden of whimsy with this beginner-friendly wool applique project! Featuring soft summer blues, warm terracotta, and crisp white, this cheerful needle keeper introduces six essential decorative stitches.
