DEPARTMENT RULES

- General rules, regulations and health requirements listed on the Iowa State Fair website and in the FFA section apply in this department, with special emphasis on the following sections: Member Eligibility, Supervision and Lodging, Good Conduct Policy, Medication and Drug Testing, and Showing and Fitting Ethics.
- Entries must be submitted online on or before July 1.** Entry fee is \$2 per entry. Each exhibitor may show a maximum of two entries in each class.
- All rabbits must be owned by the exhibitor and positively identified with a needle tattoo on or before July 1. Ownership must be maintained through exhibition at the Iowa State Fair.
- Rabbits must be designated as either market or breeding. Individual rabbits may not be exhibited in both divisions.
- Rabbits in this division must be housed in the Swine Barn.
- No rabbits will be allowed on Fairgrounds unless entered to show.
- Cages will be provided for exhibitors' rabbits. **Exhibitors shall provide wood shavings for their own rabbits.**
- All rabbits will be examined by the official show veterinarian at no expense to the exhibitor.
- Substitutions within class only.
- No changes or substitutions will be allowed after coop identification numbers are assigned following check-in.
- If five or less are entered in a class, the classes may be combined with another breed class. The supervisor reserves the right to combine breeds to make up classes.**
- Rabbits will be judged on ARBA standards.
- Each entry will receive a ribbon (purple, blue, red or white) in each class. Monetary premiums will be paid to the top three entries in each class. Premiums paid will be \$5,4,3.
- Rosettes will be awarded to the following: Champion Meat Exhibit, Reserve Champion Meat Exhibit, Champion Six Class, Reserve Champion Six Class, Champion Four Class and Reserve Champion Four Class. **Only purple and blue ribbons winners can be named Champion of a show/division/class.**
- Two "Best of Show" trophies and banners will be presented - one for Six Class and one for Four Class.

MEAT RABBITS - DIVISION 865

Pen consists of three rabbits. They do not have to be of the same litter. Meat individuals may come from an exhibitor's pen or be individuals in addition to the pen.

CLASS

- Roaster & Stewer Pen - under 6 months, 5.5-10 pounds EACH
- Fryer Pen - not over 10 weeks, 3.5-5.49 pounds EACH
- Roaster/Stewer Individual - under 6 months, 5.5-10 pounds
- Fryer Individual - not over 10 weeks, 3.5-5.49 pounds
