**FARM CROPS SCHEDULE:**

**Wednesday, August 7**

3:00 - 8:00 p.m. Entries may arrive

**Thursday, August 8**

7:00 - 9:00 a.m. Entries may arrive

9:00 a.m. Entries must be in place

9:00 a.m. Judging begins

4:30 p.m. Awards Ceremony (Participating FFA members are expected to attend and wear their exhibitor t-shirts.)

**Friday, August 9**

3:00 p.m. Entries released (All entries in **classes 1-55 and 59-62** receiving ribbon placing 1 through 3 will be required to be displayed until 7:00 p.m. release time on the last day of the Fair provided room for display exists.) **Removal of entries or ribbons placing 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> prior to the last day can result in loss of premiums.**

3:45 p.m. Entries not receiving ribbon placing must be removed or entries will be taken care of by supervisor of exhibits. The Sunday pick up of entries must be completed between 7:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. or the supervisor of exhibits will take charge of them.

- 3:30 p.m. Entries released (see rule 23)  
4:30 p.m. Entries must be out or will be disposed of

9:00 a.m. Entries must be in place

4:30 p.m. Awards Ceremony (Participating FFA members are expected to attend and wear their exhibitor t-shirts.)

- 3:00 p.m. Entries released (Please have a representative of your chapter come pick up exhibits and ribbons.)  
3:30 p.m. Entries must be out or will be disposed of or donated to a food bank
