ENTRY DEADLINE

Saturday, June 15 and Sunday, June 16 from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. in the Cultural Center. Any photos received <u>after</u> 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 16 will NOT be judged.

ENTRY RULES - READ CAREFULLY

GENERAL RULES

- IDENTITY: Under the penalty of being disqualified, by entering I certify that the photos being entered were taken by me and NOT by another person. I also certify that I have NOT submitted any additional photos under an assumed name.
- 2. **JURIED COMPETITION:** Only those photos selected by the panel of judges will be exhibited.
- 3. **ELIGIBILITY:** The same photo or similar photo previously exhibited at the Iowa State Fair is **NOT** eligible for entry.
- 4. **ORIGINALITY:** Photographers must use their own ideas and concepts when creating their photos. Do **NOT** copy, duplicate or replicate the ideas of other photographers or previous winners.
- ENTRY FEE: Entry fee is \$5 per photo. Make checks payable to the Iowa State Fair. NOTE: Any photo that does NOT meet the above requirements will NOT be judged. Entry fees will NOT be refunded.
- FAIRNESS: In the fairness of competition, please carefully read the General Guidelines For Entering Photos on page 2. The goal is to make sure that the photos in each of the classes are judged as fairly against each other as humanly possible.
- 7. **CAMERAS:** We judge your photo **NOT** what you took it with. Photos can be taken with any camera, cell phone or tablet.
- 8. **REPRODUCTION:** The Iowa State Fair reserves the right to reproduce in any form any work submitted.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE: Photos will be handled with care. However, the Iowa State Fair is NOT responsible for any loss or damage.
- 10. **GENERAL RULES:** General rules listed on the Iowa State Fair website also apply in this department.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 11. **ENTRIES:** Each photographer can enter up to four (4) photos. There is a limit of one photo per class.
- 12. **CLASSES:** Classes are determined by the main subject matter of each photo. *The same photo or similar photo cannot be entered in multiple classes.* To increase your chances of being exhibited, your photos should be of entirely different subjects.
- 13. **EDITING PHOTOS:** The Iowa State Fair photography competition is about the ART of Photography **NOT** Photoshop. Basic editing techniques are acceptable for any of the normal classes. AI may only be used as a filter capacity when applying it to an image that was taken on a camera and can only be entered in Class 41. Read the General Guidelines For Entering Photos on page 2.
- 14. **PHOTO SIZE:** Photos can be any size up to and including 11" x 14" but must be mounted on 11" x 14" foam core or gator board that is at least 1/8" thick per Rule #15.
- 15. PHOTO BACKING: All photos MUST BE MOUNTED on 11" X 14" FOAM CORE or GATOR BOARD that is AT LEAST 1/8" THICK. Exception: Photos in the PANORAMIC CLASS MUST BE MOUNTED ON 7" X 20" FOAM CORE or GATOR BOARD that is AT LEAST 1/8" THICK. Do NOT use mat board or styrene! It is highly recommended that photos be dry mounted. It is available at photo labs, art supply stores and frame shops.
- 16. *ENTRY:* Photographer's name, photo title, date of photo and other text must *NOT* appear on front of entry.
- 17. *MATS:* We judge your photo *NOT* the mat. Mat colors should NOT compete with your photo. Mats are optional.
- TITLES: We judge your photo NOT the title. The titles are for the public, NOT the judges. Please limit titles to three or four words.
- PRESENTATION: All photos must be unframed. There should be NO hooks or wires attached to the back of entries. Do NOT cover entry with cellophane, acetate or glass. There should be NO spray adhesive or self-stick adhesive exposed that could damage another person's photo.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ENTERING PHOTOS

FAIRNESS: In the fairness of competition, please note the comments below. The goal is to make sure that the photos in each of the classes are judged as fairly against each other as humanly possible.

CLASSES: If we showed your photo to a thousand people, where would their eye go to first? Classes are determined by the main subject matter of each photo. The same photo or similar photo cannot be entered in multiple classes. Photos that are the same or similar will be rejected. To increase your chances of being exhibited, your photos should be of entirely different subjects.

THEME CLASS: The theme class changes each year. It is used as a way to challenge photographers. It is also used as a way for them to learn a new skill set. It is a totally separate class from all the other classes. All your photos do **NOT** have to fit the theme each year. You only need to follow the rules of the theme class if you enter a photo in that class.

EDITING PHOTOS: The Iowa State Fair photo competition is about the ART of Photography **NOT** Photoshop. Basic editing techniques are acceptable for any of the normal classes. Some examples of basic editing include: cropping, sharpening, dodging, burning, increasing saturation, increasing contrast and removing dust spots. Be careful to NOT over-sharpen or over-saturate your photos. Photos must be from a single image. Objects from another photo cannot be added to your original image.

CLASSES 41, 42, and 43: These are reserved for photos that have been edited beyond the basic editing techniques described above.

- Class 41: Anything Goes does **NOT** mean that you can enter any photo you want. This class is reserved for photos that have been dramatically computer enhanced or radically altered.
- Class 42: Reserved for Infrared, Toned, Tinted and Solarized photos. They cannot be entered in any other classes.
- Class 43: All High Dynamic Range photos <u>must</u> be entered in this class. HDR photos cannot be entered in any other classes.

RAILROAD PHOTOS: Photos of people, including photographers, standing on railroad tracks or the right of way will be rejected.

ENTERING IN PERSON

ENTRIES ACCEPTED: Saturday, June 15 and Sunday, June 16 from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. in the **Cultural Center**.

ENTERING BY MAIL

ENTRIES ACCEPTED: Monday, May 13 - Friday, June 7. Do NOT mail before Monday, May 13. Entries by mail must be received by Friday, June 7. To enter by mail you must include your entry form, entry fee and photos in the same package. Make sure to wrap your photos with plenty of packing materials to prevent them from being damaged during shipment. You can use either of the two shipping addresses below.

UPS OR FEDEX: Iowa State Fair, Photography Salon, 3000 East Grand Avenue, Des Moines, IA 50317.

JUDGING PROCESS

JUDGING: It is **NOT** the judges' responsibility to pick out your best baby, dog, cat, bird, squirrel, flower, barn, bridge, building, sunrise, sunset, night or landscape photo. You need to prejudge your own work. During the first round of judging, all of your photos are lined up together in front of the judges. To increase your chances of being exhibited, your photos should be of entirely different subjects.

RESULTS: A results postcard will be mailed to entrants in July. Judging results will NOT be announced before the start of the lowa State Fair. A list of exhibitors who have one or more photos accepted for display will be posted on the lowa State Fair website at www.iowastatefair.org on Wednesday prior to opening day of the lowa State Fair. The judges' decisions are final.

RETURNING PHOTOS BY MAIL

PHOTOS RETURNED: Entries will be returned by mail **ONLY** if a return mailer is included with sufficient return postage and a pre-addressed shipping label. Photos will only be returned via the United States Postal Service or UPS. Please do NOT use FedEx for your return mailer.

PICKING UP PHOTOS IN PERSON

1 OR MORE PHOTOS DISPLAYED: If any of your photos are accepted for display, you must wait until the end of the Fair to pick up all your photos. See times listed below.

NO PHOTOS DISPLAYED: If none of your photos are accepted for display, you can pick up your photos at anytime during the Fair at the Photography Salon in the Cultural Center or at any of the times listed below.

CULTURAL CENTER, IOWA STATE FAIRGROUNDS

RELEASE TIME: Photos will NOT be released until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 18.

PICK UP TIMES: Sunday, August 18 from 7:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. or Monday, August 19 from Noon until 6:00 p.m.

ADMISSION: Admission will be charged at the gate on Sunday, August 18 with no on-site ticket sales and no entry/re-entry allowed after 7:00 p.m. You must be on the Fairgrounds by 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 18.

ENTRY DEPARTMENT, ADMINISTRATION BUILDING

NOTE: Photos will **NOT** be available for pick up on Tuesday, August 20.

PICK UP DATES: Wednesday, August 21 until Friday, August 30

PICK UP TIMES: Weekdays from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. and Weekends from 11:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

UNCLAIMED PHOTOS: After Friday, August 30, all unclaimed entries become the property of the Iowa State Fair and will be disposed of as deemed necessary.

- 47 ARCHITECTURE (Examples of American and International architecture, both past and present.)
- 48 FAMILY FARM (Examples of living, working, playing and way of life on a family farm.)
- 49 SPORTS (Any sports related photos, includes action and non-action photos.)
- 50 PANORAMIC (Must be mounted on 7"x20" foam core or gator board that is at least 1/8" thick. Photos can be stitched together.)

Leading Lines

"The art of photography is all about directing the attention of the viewer."

- Steven Pinker

When you look around you leading lines are everywhere. Not only do you use them everyday, you probably don't even know that you use them. What are leading lines and what do they have to do with photography you ask? Leading lines are defined as lines that appear in a photograph that have been framed and positioned by the photographer to draw the viewer's eye towards a specific point of interest. Leading lines draw the viewer's eye in a specific direction or towards a designated portion of the photograph.

Your assignment for next year is to look for the leading lines and to draw us into the photograph. Remember, lines can happen in four different ways: horizontal, vertical, diagonal and converging. The idea is to creatively use the lines to show us the world like we have never seen it before.



Learning to effectively use leading lines can help you create dynamic and powerful images that highlight your chosen subject matter. There is such a wide variety of ways that next years theme can help you grow your photography skills. It can help develop your eye to find the focal point, and teach you to look for the natural lines around you. It may even force you to look at the lines in a different perspective and to look for the light that may lead to emphasis your focal point.
