RULES

- 1. Iowa Family Living general rules and regulations apply in this department. In case general rules conflict with Heritage Department general or special rules, the latter shall govern.
- SUBMITTING ENTRIES. Entries may be submitted online or by mail. Online entry and a printable lowa Family Living entry form are available at: <u>https://www.iowastatefair.org/participate/competition/enter-iowa-family-living</u>. If entering online, payment will be collected at time of entry. If entering by mail, complete entry form and return it with full payment of all fees to: Iowa State Fair, Iowa Family Living Entry Department, PO Box 57130, Des Moines, IA 50317-0003.
- 3. ENTRY DEADLINE IS JULY 1. Entries must be submitted online or postmarked on or before July 1.
- 4. ENTRY FEES. Each exhibitor, as a requirement for entry, will pay a \$10 department fee plus \$.50 per entry. One tag will be issued for each entry. Exception: Limited Division entry fee is \$8 (and department fee).
- 5. LATE ENTRIES. A \$20 department fee plus class fees will be charged for all entries submitted online or postmarked July 2 July 8. No entries will be accepted after July 8.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

- 6. Entries in this department are limited to living residents of lowa.
- 7. Exhibitors are limited to one entry in each class. Exhibitors are limited to one class in Large Item Collections, Division 715.
- 8. No articles will be accepted after being shown two consecutive years. Articles cannot be shown both in individual classes and collections.
- 9. Exhibits or artifacts are to be genuine articles at least 50 years old. Judges will consider authenticity and condition of exhibits. <u>Reproductions are</u> not acceptable entries.

ENTRY TAGS

10. Entry tags will be mailed to you to be completed and placed on articles by you before delivery. No untagged articles will be accepted. A completed Entry List of all items brought must accompany articles.

DELIVERY OF ENTRIES

- Articles are to be delivered to Pioneer Hall on Sunday, August 4 from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. or on Monday, August 5 from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. You will need a Pre-Fair permit to bring your vehicle onto the Fairgrounds to drop off your exhibit(s). Request this permit at time of entry and it will be mailed with your entry tag(s).
- 12. Articles entered may be sent by mail. For standard mail, send to: Iowa State Fair, Heritage Department, PO Box 57130, Des Moines, IA 50317. For UPS or FedEx, send to: Iowa State Fair, Heritage Department, 3000 East Grand Avenue, Des Moines, IA 50317. Articles must be received by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, August 2. In no case will packages be received and articles placed on exhibition unless all charges are prepaid.

JUDGING

- 13. Judges decisions are final. In classes with limited entries, the judges will make the placing according to the quality of the articles.
- 14. A Sweepstakes rosette will be awarded in Divisions 700-714.

RECLAIMING ENTRIES

- 15. NO ARTICLES WILL BE RELEASED FROM THIS DEPARTMENT UNTIL MONDAY, AUGUST 19. Articles may be picked up on Monday, August 19 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in Pioneer Hall. Articles will be returned by mail or UPS providing postage is furnished to the Superintendent.
- 16. Beginning Wednesday, August 21 and until Friday, August 30, articles can be picked up in the Entry Department located on the lower east side of the Administration Building. Hours are 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. weekdays and 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 24 and Sunday, August 25. (Please note: Entries will not be available for pick up on Tuesday, August 20.) After August 30, all unclaimed items become the property of the lowa State Fair and will be disposed of as deemed necessary.

LIABILITY
