- Entrant must be a member of the International Chili Society. You can sign up for a one time \$10 membership fee (1-Cook Pass) at <u>www.chilicookoff.com</u>. Membership fee is paid online. Register on the ICS website prior to submitting payment for class entry fee(s) to the Fair.
- 4. Entry fee for each class is \$35. Send payment and form to: Iowa State Fair, Entry Coordinator, PO Box 57130, Des Moines IA 50317. Include contact information contestant name, address, phone number and email. Make checks payable to Iowa State Fair.
- 5. Entries are limited to the first 20 contestants in each class.
- 6. One admission ticket is included with your entry fee(s). The cut-off date for admission ticket to be mailed is August 1. If entry is received after August 1, you will need to pay regular admission at the gate.
- 7. You will be provided a vehicle pass to bring your chili supplies to the cooking location. Setup can begin at 7:00 a.m. Cooks meeting will be at 8:30 a.m.
- 8. All cooking must be done on-site on August 17 in front of the Elwell Family Food Center (west side of the Fairgrounds). Entrant needs to furnish the equipment for cooking; no electricity will be provided.
- 9. Homestyle Chili Cooking time will be will be from 9:00 a.m. Noon. Judging will begin at 12:15 p.m.
- 10. Entries for Homestyle Chili can be any combination of meats, cooked with chili peppers, various other spices and other ingredients. Must contain beans.
- 11. Traditional Red Chili Cooking time will be from 10:00 a.m. 1:00 p.m. Judging will begin at 1:15 p.m.
- 12. Entries for Traditional Red Chili (no beans or pasta) can be any combination of meats, cooked with chili peppers, various other spices and other ingredients.
- 13. Entries must follow the International Chili Society Chili rules.
- 14. Entrants will cook a minimum of two quarts of chili.
- 15. Entries will be judged on Good Chili Flavor, Texture of the Meat, Consistency/Blend of Spices, Aroma and Color.
