## **POLICY 310: POLITICAL ACTIVITY**

---

The purpose of this policy is to establish clear guidelines governing political activities on the Iowa State Fairgrounds in a manner that protects constitutional rights while ensuring public safety, orderly operations, and the uninterrupted conduct of scheduled events:

- The Iowa State Fair recognizes and respects the constitutional right to lawful expression under the First Amendment.
- This policy is content-neutral and applies equally to all persons and viewpoints.
- Reasonable time, place, and manner restrictions may be imposed to ensure safety, access, and event continuity.

### **Guidelines during the Iowa State Fair**

Political candidates must purchase admission and parking for the Fair.

Space is not provided for meet-and-greets, campaign rallies, fundraisers or other political events during the Fair.

### **Guidelines for Non-Fair Events**

Space can be rented through a contractual agreement during non-Fair times. All contracts shall follow normal Fair policy and procedures governing non-Fair events.
