March 23, 2026 (Los Angeles, CA)—Multi-platinum, GRAMMY® Award-winning supergroups **Salt-n-Pepa** and **TLC** are joining forces for a landmark co-headlining tour across North America, with special guest **En Vogue**. Produced by Live Nation, the **TLC & SaltN-Pepa with En Vogue - IT'S ICONIC** tour marks the first time these three trailblazing groups will tour together, celebrating decades of era-defining hits, culture-shifting influence, and timeless R&B and hip-hop anthems.

Spanning amphitheaters and arenas nationwide, the tour will deliver a powerhouse night of hits including “No Scrubs,” “Waterfalls,” “Push It,” “Shoop,” “Free Your Mind,” and “Don’t Let Go (Love),” bringing together three of the

ABOUT TLC

TLC is the bestselling American girl group of all time and has spent over three decades breaking boundaries and empowering generations. The TLC story is one of sisterhood, strength and survival against the odds, having overcome extraordinary circumstances to become one of the most influential acts in pop music.

Their unique combination of chemistry, cultural impact and commercial success remains unmatched, with four multi-platinum albums and #1 singles, and over 30 major music awards- including five Grammys. TLC has sold over 85 million records globally, reaching #1 in almost every major country in the world. Their journey encompasses immortal anthems such as 'Waterfalls', 'Creep', 'No Scrubs' and 'Unpretty'.

When "T-Boz" Watkins, Rozonda "Chilli" Thomas and the late Lisa "Left Eye" Lopes founded TLC in the early 90s, they immediately broke new ground. The Atlanta trio's 1992 debut *Oooooohhh... On the TLC Tip* landed a new

blend of R&B and rap in the charts and marked TLC out as a band with a message, with their baggy clothing and songs about female pleasure. *CrazySexyCool* followed in 1994 and took TLC stratospheric. It sold a staggering 23 million copies worldwide and, with 'Waterfalls', sensitively tackled issues like the AIDS crisis and gang violence. It was the first video from a female group to win Video of The Year at the MTV Music Awards.

On 1999's *Fanmail*, TLC mapped out a vision of a postmillennium world with their futuristic take on R&B. The album featured another timeless classic, 'No Scrubs', as well as TBoz's self-penned empowerment song 'Unpretty'. TLC laid the blueprint for the American girlband, setting the stage for the groups that followed. Beyoncé said: "TLC has influenced just about every female group that's out there now, and they definitely influenced Destiny's Child", while Missy Elliott says of TLC now that they are "Legends. Icons. They will go down in the history books."

The rise, resilience, and rhythm of the most successful female group of all time takes center stage in *CrazySexyCool—The TLC Musical*, the chart-topping, world-premiere musical at **Arena Stage** in Washington, D.C. from **June 12– August 9, 2026**. This electrifying new production celebrates the sisterhood who dared to be bold, courageous, and wholly themselves—and in doing so, became truly iconic.

Today, the group's influence is everywhere from hip-hop to K-Pop: artists like Nicki Minaj, Cardi B, Doja Cat, Kelahni, Tinashe, Rihanna, Arnie Lennox and BLACKPINK all credit TLC as an inspiration, or have referenced them in their visuals. And their cultural impact continues to extend beyond music: TLC's unconventional approach to style has inspired artists in every field, as has their fearless representation of femininity and self-expression across the decades.

ABOUT SALT-N-PEPA

From Queens to global rap royalty, Salt-N-Pepa—the groundbreaking duo of Cheryl "Salt" James and Sandra "Pepa" Denton—forever changed the face and sound of hip-hop. Breaking barriers at every level, they became the first all-female rap group to earn platinum certification, and later the first female hip-hop group—and the first group of any genre—inducted under the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame's prestigious Influence category. Their fearless lyrics, infectious energy, and unapologetic femininity paved the way for generations of women in music and beyond.

Emerging during hip-hop's golden era, Salt-N-Pepa brought fun, fashion, and femininity to a genre often dominated by men. With their signature confidence and "around the way" authenticity, they gave women permission to be bold, expressive, and empowered.

The duo's story began in New York City, where Salt, from Brooklyn, and Pepa, born in Jamaica and raised in Queens, met while attending Queensborough Community College. Their chemistry caught the attention of producer Hurby "Luv Bug" Azor, who created their first single, "The Showstopper." Soon joined by Deidra "Spinderella" Roper, a DJ from Brooklyn who became one of the most celebrated female DJs in hip-hop, Salt-N-Pepa quickly became a cultural force.

Their 1986 debut album, *Hot, Cool & Vicious*, introduced the world to the anthem "Push It"—a track that became an instant classic and propelled the album to multi-platinum status. They followed with *A Salt with a Deadly Pepa* (1988) and *Blacks' Magic* (1990) which cemented their reputation as bold voices for women, delivering empowering anthems like "Expression," "Independent," and "Let's Talk About Sex."

In 1993, their blockbuster album *Very Necessary* became one of the best-selling rap albums of all time by a female group, featuring timeless hits "Shoop," "Whatta Man" (featuring En Vogue), and "None of Your Business." The latter earned them a GRAMMY Award for Best Rap Performance by a Duo or Group in 1995—making them the first women in hip-hop to win in that category.

More than three decades after breaking barriers in hip-hop, Salt-N-Pepa's cultural influence remains indelible. Their sold-out shows and global performances speak to a legacy that continues to inspire new generations. Over the years, they've received countless honors and accolades —most recently a GRAMMY Lifetime Achievement Award (2021), a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame (2022), and induction into the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame (2025) —cementing their impact on music and culture for generations to come.

Salt-N-Pepa's legacy is more than music —it's empowerment, resilience, and joy. As Salt reflects, "We've always represented women as bosses, as mothers, as survivors —real women who keep it pushing." Pepa adds, "We're still here with timeless music, proving that hip-hop is here to stay. And I'm proud of that."

ABOUT EN VOGUE

En Vogue is one of the most successful and influential female vocal groups in modern music history—and remains a powerful brand nearly four decades after their debut.

With over 20 million records sold worldwide, seven studio albums, six No. 1 R&B singles, multiple Grammy nominations, American Music Awards, Soul Train Awards, and three MTV VMAs, En Vogue ranks among Billboard's Top 10 Most Successful Girl Groups of All Time. Their groundbreaking catalog—including "Hold On," "My Lovin' (You're Never Gonna Get It)," "Free Your Mind," "Whatta Man," and "Don't Let Go (Love)"—helped redefine contemporary R&B and set the vocal and visual standard for the generation of girlgroups that followed.

Formed in Oakland by producers Denzil Foster and Thomas McElroy, the group fused classic R&B harmonies with hip-hop edge, delivering a sound that reshaped pop culture and expanded what a female vocal group could be: musically sophisticated, fashion-forward, vocally elite, and socially aware.

Their multi-platinum 1992 album *Funky Divas* remains one of the bestselling R&B albums of its era, with more than 5 million units sold worldwide and triple-platinum U.S. certification. Across their catalog, En Vogue has consistently delivered crossover success, international chart performance, and enduring radio staples.

Today, original members Cindy Herron, Terry Ellis, and Maxine Jones continue to headline major national and international events, including the 2025 NBA All-Star Game in San Francisco and the 2025 Glastonbury Festival. Their recent high-profile appearances include performances for hip hop icons Salt-N-Pepa's Rock & Roll Hall of Fame Induction broadcast and feature placements in film and television projects including *Coming 2 America*, *The Masked Singer*, and Lifetime's *An En Vogue Christmas*.

Beyond music, the members of En Vogue bring decades of experience in television, film, live hosting, and branded entertainment. Their combined backgrounds include acting, soundtrack placements, broadcast performances, and cultural tribute programming —positioning them for biopic development, residency opportunities, legacy tours, festival headlining, guest hosting, television specials, and brand partnerships.

En Vogue represents a rare combination of proven commercial success, crossgenerational audience recognition, they are music veterans with active touring capacity, on-camera fluency, and continued relevance in today's entertainment landscape.

En Vogue remains a timeless brand—rooted in excellence, poised for the next chapter.
