To Non-Registered Campers:

- The campgrounds will open on Sunday, August 4<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m. for non-registered, land rush campers. Non-registered campers are allowed to line-up in the Lot A parking lot starting Sunday, July 28<sup>th</sup> at 6 a.m. Campers arriving on **July 28<sup>th</sup>** will pay \$15 for the first day, then \$10 per day parking fee until August 4<sup>th</sup> when the campground opens. Campers will NOT need to keep their tow vehicle hooked to their camper.
- We will be registering you in the Lot A parking lot at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday, August 4<sup>th</sup>. Please be hooked up and ready to move to the campgrounds at 8:00 a.m. If you are not registered and hooked up by 8:00 a.m., you will have to go to the end of the line.
- 3. On Sunday, August 4<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m., we will be allowing ten campers at a time in to the Campgrounds.
- 4. Please do not have someone try to save your spot by standing on it, parking on it, or any other method. We are doing this so that people who have been waiting in line the longest will have first chance at the various camping spots still open.
- 5. Please be sure not to camp on any area where there is a yellow flag.
- 6. When you get your camper parked in the Campgrounds please fill out the white card and turn it in to the office. This is for emergency purposes only. It has nothing to do with getting you pre-registered for next year.
- 7. No Romex is allowed in the Campgrounds.
- Please understand that the camping spot you find does not mean that you have a camping spot for 2025. You will not be sent information for 2025. A registration form will need to be sent to the Iowa State Fair between January 1<sup>st</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>. It is taking 20 years or more to get a permanent camping spot.
- 9. No switching campers once you are in line.
- 10. We do not guarantee electrical hook-ups to non-registered campers.
- 11. No heavy equipment will be allowed in the campgrounds for leveling.
