A NATIONAL YMCA TASK FORCE ANNUALLY ESTABLISHES A RECOMMENDED SALARY POLICY LINE FOR EACH COMING YEAR BASED UPON VARIOUS ECONOMIC CONDITIONS AND THE ASSOCIATION'S FINANCIAL POSITION. ONCE THIS REVIEW PROCESS IS COMPLETED, THE PERSONNEL COMMITTEE MAY RECOMMEND THE ADOPTION OF A NEW SALARY POLICY LINE TO THE YMCA BOARD OF DIRECTORS. IN ADDITION TO REVIEWING THE SALARY POLICY LINE EACH YEAR, THE YMCA'S PERSONNEL COMMITTEE REVIEWS AND RECOMMENDS A MERIT POOL INCREASE TO THE YMCA'S FINANCE COMMITTEE AND YMCA BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR ADOPTION. ONCE A FULL ANNUAL YMCA OPERATING BUDGET IS ENDORSED BY THE YMCA BOARD OF DIRECTORS IN DECEMBER OF EACH YEAR, THE APPROVED SALARY INCREASES ARE IMPLEMENTED BASED UPON THE EMPLOYEES ANNUAL SALARY REVIEW DATES. THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S COMPENSATION PROCESS IS THE SAME WITH THE EXCEPTION OF BEING EVALUATED BY THE YMCA VOLUNTARY COMMITTEE CHAIRS AND BOARD OFFICERS; WHILE THE REMAINDER OF THE YMCA STAFF IS EVALUATED BY THEIR DEPARTMENT HEADS. THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SIGNS OFF ON ALL COMPENSATION CHANGES BEFORE THE PAYROLL PROCESS BEGINS.</p> |
