OUR CENTERS CLOSED ON MARCH 16, 2020 DUE TO THE PANDEMIC. OUR SANTA BARBARA CENTER RE-OPENED ON MARCH 30TH TO PROVIDE CARE TO THE CHILDREN OF ESSENTIAL WORKERS AND FIRST RESPONDERS. STRICT CENTER FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH PROTOCOLS WERE FOLLOWED WHICH INCLUDED TEMPERATURE CHECKS, FREQUENT HAND WASHING, MASK WEARING FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF, AND SEPARATE INDOOR AND OUTDOOR SHOES FOR ALL CHILDREN AND STAFF. OUR MOORING'S LOCATION RE-OPENED ON MAY 18, 2020. OUR ENROLLMENT NUMBERS WERE VERY LOW INITIALLY BETWEEN BOTH CENTERS: WITH MINIMAL ENROLLMENTS OF: 9 TOTAL CHILDREN IN MARCH 2020, 13 CHILDREN IN APRIL, 35 CHILDREN IN MAY, 46 CHILDREN IN JUNE AND 52 CHILDREN IN JULY. OUR TWO PROGRAMS INSIDE OF COLLIER COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS OPENED AT THE END OF AUGUST AND OUR ENROLLMENT NUMBERS RETURNED TO CLOSER TO TYPICAL. REMAINING OPEN AND OPERATIONAL DURING A PANDEMIC HAS NOT BEEN WITHOUT IT'S CHALLENGES, BUT WITH A TREMENDOUS AMOUNT OF WORK AND DEDICATION ON BEHALF OF THE STAFF, CHILD'S PATH WAS ABLE TO RE-OPEN VERY QUICKLY FOLLOWING THE FORCED CLOSURE BY THE GOVERNMENT AT THE BEGINNING OF THE PANDEMIC HELPING ENSURE THE COMMUNITY AND ESPECIALLY THE CHILDREN CONTINUED TO BE SERVED.
