BETHANY PROVIDED SHORT-TERM, GOAL-ORIENTED THERAPY AND NURSING CARE TO 631 PEOPLE AT THE BETHANY REHABILITATION CENTER. OVER 60% OF THE PEOPLE SERVED RETURNED TO THEIR PREVIOUS HOMES AFTER RECOVERY. BETHANY PROVIDED OVER \$4.0 MILLION IN UNCOMPENSATED CHARITABLE CARE DURING THE PERIOD.
