WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM The Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP) is a no cost assistance program designed to increase energy efficiency of dwellings owned or occupied by income-eligible households. The goal is to reduce their energy expenditures and to improve their overall health and safety. HWAP promotes energy efficiency, by providing services that include insulation, duct sealing, weather stripping and heating systems upgrades. This program is federally funded by the U.S. Department of Energy and is provided for customers, whose annual household income is at or below 200% of the federal poverty quidelines. After weatherization, households that heat with natural gas reduce space heating consumption by an average of 24 7%, and electrically heated homes decrease their usage on an average of 13% HWAP services reduced the percentage of the utility bills that their customers pay. In addition, the rate of utility services disconnections for this group was decreased by 50% In 2016, Community Action Partnership provided APPROXimateLY 1,135 households in Auglaize, Butler, Darke, Greene, Mercer, Montgomery, Preble and Warren

COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM The Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) Program provides a variety of services aimed at assisting with basic needs and moving individuals and families on the road to becoming self-sufficient. The program is designed to provide for maximum flexibility to meet locally defined needs. In 2016, CSBG services were provided to households with incomes up to 125% of the federal poverty quidelines. Activities that were provided included advocacy, information

and referral, case management services, computer literacy training, micro-enterprise business and development training, income tax filing, transportation services, transitional housing, home foreclosure counseling assistance, first-time home buying counseling, job readiness training and placement and youth programming. In addition, work and interview clothing, shoes and employment documentation (i.e., state identification and/or birth certificates) were provided with CSBG funds.

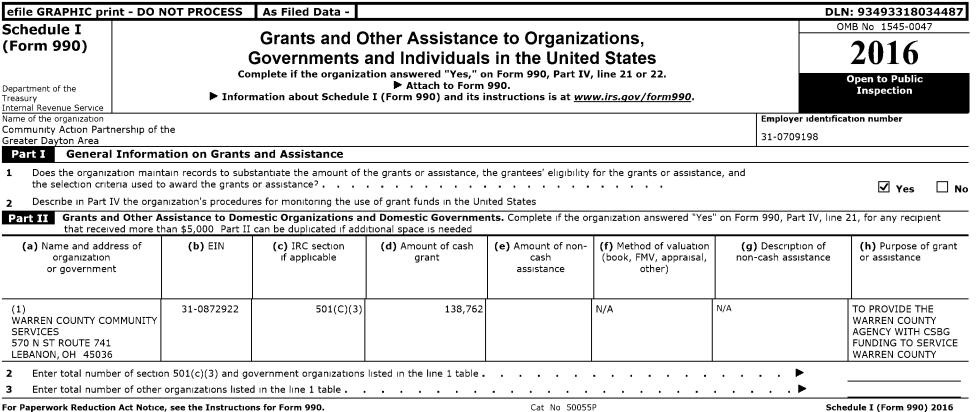
