PARENT TRAINING AND INFORMATION CENTER (U.S. Dept of Ed./Office of Special Ed Programs Grant)
Purpose: provide training, information & support to families of children with disabilities & others in WI. Trained 6,947 persons. Reached 2,220 parents & 443 professionals through calls, emails, letters and in-person meetings. Conducted 50 statewide exhibits & disseminated 24,200 pieces of information. Social media efforts reached 242,452. Project staff attended 282 stakeholder/policy/task force meetings to work on systems changes initiatives. Supported families at 66 IEP meetings, 8 home visits, and 14 mediations and facilitated IEPs. Outcomes: 181 trainings were conducted and 89% of training participants reported that the content was useful. 100% indicated that the information/support provided to them met their needs. 100% of parents and youth also reported an increase in confidence in utilizing leadership and/or self-advocacy skills.

REGIONAL PARENT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CENTER (U.S. Dept of Ed./Office of Special Ed Programs Cooperative Agreement)
Purpose: provision of technical assistance to OSEP-funded parent centers. # served: 11 federally-funded parent centers in 8 states (IA, IL, IN, MI, MN, OH, WI). The project website (www.region4ta.us) contains archived webinars and many online resources to assist parent centers to implement their grants. Over 165 direct requests for TA were responded to; a weekly Region 4 Newsbrief was published with resources related to: nonprofit management, technology, outreach, parent services, multicultural issues, education practices, etc. A 2 1/2 day Regional Working Meeting reached 55 parent center staff and board members. A University-sponsored nonprofit management certificate program with 12 hours of programming was provided. A cohort group of Spanish-speaking parent center staff was convened to address issues related to serving Spanish-speaking families more effectively. Outcomes: 86% of training participants reported webinars were of high quality. 88% of individuals from parent centers who received technical assistance said it was useful and relevant to the work they are doing.

Purpose: To increase the participation of family and community members in the systems change process of selected schools through the use of professional development 13 Serving on Groups that Make Decisions trainings were conducted, reaching 289 parents and professionals. The WI Family Engagement Newsletter was published 12 times that reached 32,776. Topics included: Bullying, ADD/ADHD, Communication, Learning Disabilities, Epilepsy, Assistive Technology, Intellectual Disabilities, Transition, Traumatic Brain Injury, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Early Childhood, Emotional Behavioral Disabilities. Self-paced online learning modules can be found on the website: www.servingongroups.org Outcomes: 93% of participants found the training to be of a high quality; 96% found the training content useful; and 97% would share the training with others.
