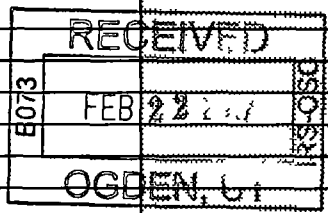

NOL Carryback Election
