
Congrats 2025 Graduates!

In June and July, AIMS **Neurodiagnostic** Technology students received virtual guest lectures from two renowned doctors in their field: Dr. Faisal Jahangiri and Dr. Stephen Wong. Dr. Wong's session focused on "Pattern Recognition of EEG Epochs", where he provided an exploration of epileptic dysfunction zones, aura localization, seizure/aura symptomatology, and the distinctions between seizures and epilepsy.

Throughout his lecture, Dr. Jahangiri provided guidance on Somatosensory Evoked Potentials (SSEPs) and proper electrode placement. He also provided the students with real-world examples from the thousands of monitored procedures he's supervised across global hospitals.
