



- Package 2 Bid documents expected to be released for subcontractor pricing – TBD. Package 2 will include all scope division (2 through 17), with remaining work from Bid Package 1.

PROJECT UPDATE CENTRAL ENERGY PLANT UPGRADES

- Replace two 1100 KW essential generators with 2500 KW units.
- Relocate the 1600 KW portable generator to the chiller stand by system.
- A new dedicated fuel oil system to serve existing and new generators.
- New generator ventilation louvers.
- One new 1500 ton chiller to replace an existing 900 ton unit.
- Two new PCHP pumps for existing chillers D & E.
- Ten (10) new Automatic Transfer Switches in existing buildings.

PROJECT UPDATE

- Early Enabling Bid Packages were issued for advertisement on May 10th and Bids are due on June 2nd.
- Early Enabling Work Packages includes the following:
 - Construction of a temporary Staff/Patient Corridor and a temporary Egress Stair (SBE Set-Aside)
 - Relocation of existing utilities feeding the current Rehab Hospital
 - Demolition of the existing Institute & Annex Building
- A separate Sitework and Landscape bid package required for the Enabling Work will be issued for bidding in late May.


