Subject: Verification of On-boarding Compliance for Research

Team

I. Purpose

To establish a method of assuring that all research personnel have the appropriate privileges, prior to initiating research activities, at Jackson Health System (JHS) facilities.

II. Definitions

Privileges: Credentialing approval and competencies required to perform clinical interventions or non-clinical activities.

III. Procedure

- 1. At the time of study submission, a representative of the JHS Clinical Trials Office will verify the researcher's privileges in Jet Portal or with the Department of Medical Staff.
- 2. Research personnel that have not secured privileges at JHS facilities will be directed to the Department of Medical Staff or Human Resources Compliance to complete the privileging process.
- 3. Once privileges have been confirmed by the JHS Clinical Trials Office, the research personnel will be able to perform research activities.
 - a. Physicians, Fellows, Residents, Medical Students
 - i. Verify that personnel are Institutional Review Board (IRB) approved.
 - ii. Verify with Department of Medical Staff or by reviewing JetPortal.
 - iii. Verify with Graduate Medical Education.
 - Research Nurses not employed by JHS
 - i. Verify that personnel are IRB approved.
 - ii. Verify that Human Resource Compliance has received all necessary paperwork to provide privileges.
 - iii. Verify that a job description of research activities has been issued to the JHS Clinical Trials office.
 - iv. A JHS badge will be provided to the personnel once the process is complete.
 - v. Ensure that competency trainings have been completed before starting research activities.
 - c. Other research personnel not employed by JHS
 - a. Verify that personnel are IRB approved.
 - b. Verify that personnel have certifications for the needed research assessments and/or evaluations.
- 4. Monitoring Requirements
 - The JHS Clinical Trials Office will maintain the supporting documentation from Human Resource Compliance and job description pertaining to University of Miami (UM) Research Nurse per study.
 - b. The JHS Clinical Trials Office will involve different internal stakeholders to monitor if privileged personnel have only conducted research activities.
