The [Miami Transplant Institute](#) at the University of Miami/Jackson Memorial Hospital is one of the world's largest and most comprehensive transplant centers. As a center of excellence, we offer exceptional care in the areas of kidney, liver, heart and pancreatic transplants, as well as being pioneers in multi-organ transplantation. The Solid Organ Transplantation rotation at Jackson Memorial Hospital provides the student/resident with an opportunity to participate as an active member of a multi-disciplinary health care team in both an inpatient and outpatient settings. The student/resident will have the opportunity to round with the assigned liver and GI transplant teams and contribute to the continuum of transplant care of adult patients. Our transplant population provides a variety of learning experiences including both acute and chronic medical and surgical issues, from post-operative management to end-stage liver disease and long-term complications of immunocompromised patients. Clinical pharmacists are directly involved in patient care decisions, immunosuppressive management, daily rounds and education/training of patient and staff. In addition, pharmacotherapeutic and pharmacokinetic principles, problem-solving, documentation, communication, and drug information skills are emphasized on a daily basis through interaction with patients and other health care professionals.
