RE:	Jackson Miracle-Building Bond Quarterly Report – July to September 2020

During the fourth quarter of FY 2020, the Jackson Bond Citizens' Advisory Committee met once to discuss updates presented by staff. Four projects were presented for approval during this reporting period. Formal close-outs of five bond-funded projects were also presented to the committee.

Equipment and technology purchases under the bond during the period represent approximately \$3.44 million of Miracle-Building Bond proceeds. The largest purchases in those categories included compressor condensers, OR medical equipment, an OR Hitachi ultrasound and an OR cooler system at Jackson Memorial Hospital, pediatric ultrasound and Vapotherm respiratory therapy equipment at Holtz Children's Hospital, anesthesia machines and ultrasound equipment at Jackson North Medical Center, ultrasound machines and ventilators at Jackson South Medical Center, and capital equipment and video towers for the Ambulatory Care Center.

As staff completes the purchases of previously-approved major technology and equipment, our aggressive negotiations and procurement procedures are resulting in substantial savings compared to budget and funds approved by the committee and the Public Health Trust Board of Trustees. These savings are detailed in the attachments to this report, just as savings from under-budget completion of capital projects are detailed in close-out reports.

This explains the net negative numbers in this quarter's bond dashboard.

## **Financial Update**

Reimbursements received during the report timeframe totaled \$16,183,545 bringing to \$636,398,088 the total reimbursement received since the bond program began.

## **Small-Business Enterprise Contracting**

During this reporting period, 112 contracts were awarded totaling \$22,571,290. Eight of those projects, or 7.14%, were awarded to prime contractors who are certified small business enterprises (SBEs).

At the committee meeting on October 25, 2017, the committee requested the subsequent quarterly reports include a summary of the ethnic and gender data provided by the vendors for all contracts awarded during the reporting period. For the current reporting period, the following data was compiled:

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


### **Rehabilitation Center**

Demolition work of the old Jackson Rehabilitation Hospital has been postponed due to COVID-19 preparedness. The demolition, remaining site work, and landscaping will be completed once the additional bed capacity is deemed not necessary.



#### Jackson West



Construction continues at Jackson West Medical Center. The installation of finishes is underway on the first and second floors of the hospital and in the medical office building, while the installation of drywall and mechanical/plumbing continues on floors three through six. The delivery of medical equipment is expected to begin in late 2020. All major infrastructure connections to the site have been completed, including permanent FPL power, natural gas, domestic water, etc. Site work pavement and landscaping is ongoing, as well as exotic plant removal in the retention pond. The facility is scheduled to open in spring 2021.

## Urgent Care Centers



There were no substantial changes to the timelines for already-announced UHealth Jackson Urgent Care centers during this reporting period.

## **Equipment and Technology Purchases**

Bond proceeds were used this quarter to fund \$3,442,520 in miscellaneous medical equipment and technology, including \$88,198 from the New Hospital Facilities Renovations and Upgrades area and \$3,354,322 from New Medical Equipment. Those funds are being used at the following Jackson sites:

## **Additional Project Updates**

At Jackson South Medical Center, in mid-September work began on the next phase of renovations of the central surgical unit on the second floor, which had been put on hold to maximize bed capacity for COVID-19. The last portion of the roof replacements on the campus - the lower roof over behavioral health – is scheduled for completion next quarter. All seven elevators have been refurbished, which completes the elevator improvements in the facility.

At Jackson North Medical Center, renovations were completed on patient floors 3, 5, and 6 of the East Wing, with the fourth floor scheduled for completion in November. The oxygen tank farm has been installed and is pending connection to the hospital next quarter. The next phase of the emergency department and operating room renovations, as well as the CT replacement, are nearing completion, with AHCA inspections scheduled for late October. The X-ray replacement is complete pending final fire inspection.

At the Jackson Memorial Medical Center campus, construction continues on the new Diagnostic Treatment Center Critical Care Tower, with exterior framing finishing while stucco and exterior painting have commenced. Interior finishes, such as painting and millwork, are underway while the team prepares for the startup of all mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems. Work on the patient and public elevators continues as the project targets an early 2021 completion. Renovation work on the labor and delivery unit in East Tower 4B at The Women's Hospital at Jackson Memorial began at the end of the quarter and design efforts are underway for two CT scanners approved last quarter.

Five bond-funded projects were formally closed during the reporting period, meaning the contracts were completed and all payments fully reconciled. Further details of these projects are provided in the attached project closeout forms.
