## Fire Safety

<b>Business Purpose</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Five Starr Communications and Design has experienced a significant amount of rapid growth over the last year, expanding to multiple locations and increasing their total number of employees by 300 percent.</li><li>• This has led to some challenges in the way training has historically been provided (onsite instructor led group trainings) and there is a need to deliver compliance trainings to all employees through a more accessible and easily trackable method.</li><li>• Additionally, it is important to ensure that all employees receive fire safety training as the company now operates out of multiple locations, some with trained first responders and some without. All employees need to have a basic knowledge of fire safety and their role in preventing and responding to fire emergencies.</li><li>• The company has requested that the fire safety training be implemented at least one month prior to the end of the fiscal year, providing approximately 30 days for all employees to complete this training before the new fiscal year starts.</li><li>• Training the employees on fire safety will decrease potential instances of fires and will allow all employees to know the proper techniques to use in responding to fire emergencies.</li></ul>
<b>Target Audience</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All employees of the company as part of their annual compliance requirement</li><li>• New employees as part of their initial orientation experience</li></ul>
<b>Training Time</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The training time will be approximately 20 minutes.</li><li>• Training time accounts for the number of lessons, the content provided to support each learning objective, as well as knowledge checks and the final assessment.</li></ul>
<b>Training Recommendation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• One interactive e-Learning course developed in Articulate Rise. The e-Learning delivery format will allow this course to reach all individuals at the company since the course can be accessed at any time by the learner based upon their own schedule constraints. Additionally, the course can be taken from any location where the learner has access to a laptop, tablet, or smartphone.</li><li>• Use of Rise as the training tool will allow a quick development turnaround time to meet the new compliance deadline.</li><li>• The e-Learning course will include knowledge checks and a variety of interactions.</li></ul>
