

Adopting from PAWHS Design Document

<i>Business Purpose</i>	Partnership of Animal Welfare Humane Society (PAWHS) is a non-profit, no kill animal shelter. The client requests a training to help ensure that the people who are applying for adoption of shelter animals have are fully prepared for the responsibility of owning a pet and understand the timeline for a pet to become adjusted to their home.
<i>Target Audience</i>	People who are adopting animals from PAWHS
<i>Training Time</i>	30 minutes
<i>Training Recommendation</i>	PAWHS relies mostly on volunteers with only a few paid employees. That being said, it is most effective to offer this training so that individuals can take the course before coming to PAWHS to fill out the final paperwork and pick up their adopted pet. Since most people communicate with PAWHS through social media or by phone, offering an easy to access eLearning module that can be accessed via a smart phone is the most effective way to proceed.
