

Over the last decade, Jackson Health System has renovated aged facilities, built new ones, and made smart investments in the latest technology and equipment, thanks to an \$830 million Jackson Miracle-Building Bond approved by Miami-Dade voters in 2013 and the health system's own reinvestments. That capital plan has now exceeded \$2 million – and more construction is on the horizon as we continue to build a new Jackson.

The next major project is a new, 170,000 square-foot emergency department at Jackson Memorial Hospital, which will include 116 adult emergency beds, four resuscitation rooms, fast-track exam spaces, 24 pediatric treatment beds, a 60-bed observation unit on the second floor, and diagnostics.

Set to open in early 2023 is Jackson's first freestanding emergency department, Jackson Medical Pavilion, in Coral Gables. The facility will include an emergency room staffed by Jackson's highly skilled board-certified physicians and compassionate nurses. The site will also house medical offices for outpatient visits with Jackson doctors.

The Future of Jackson





Jackson is also in the planning phases of a new UHealth Jackson Children's Care outpatient pavilion that would house numerous specialties under one roof. The new facility, which will be built on the Jackson Memorial Medical Center campus just steps from Holtz Children's Hospital, will provide patients with a one-stop shop for comprehensive clinical services. It will also be home to the Shriners Children's Orthopedic Center at UHealth Jackson Children's Care, following an unprecedented \$16 million grant from Shriners Hospitals for Children to Jackson Health Foundation and UHealth – University of Miami Health System. The facility will create a new regional center of excellence that will advance world-class care for children with traumatic injuries and debilitating conditions, such as spina bifida, muscular dystrophy, and cerebral palsy.

Renovations will also continue inside of Holtz Children's Hospital, including a new emergency department that will include 24 exam rooms, five triage rooms, two resuscitation rooms, and four behavioral health rooms. Just steps from there, a new Ronald McDonald House is being built – a 60,000 square-foot facility with 48 hotel suits with family-friendly amenities for the families of pediatric patients receiving care at Holtz Children's.
