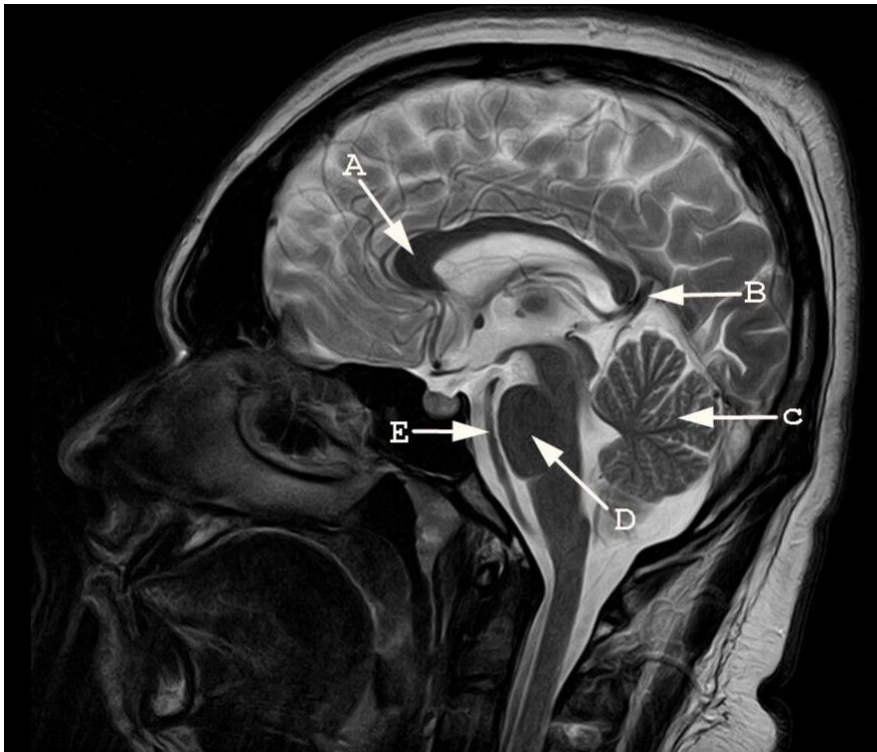


### Sagittal image from T<sub>2</sub>W MRI of the brain
