# Antibiotic Prophylaxis May Not Reduce Recurrent Febrile Urinary Tract Infection

In a randomized controlled trial, antibiotic prophylaxis did not reduce the rate of febrile urinary tract infection recurrence in children with or without primary nonsevere vesicoureteral reflux.

#### Inhaled Nitric Oxide Promising for Preterm Infants

#### Pulse Oximetry Screening Fails to Spot Congenital Heart Defects in Neonates

Pulse oximetry screening of neonates at 4 hours of age is not effective in detecting critical congenital heart defects, Dallas-based researchers report in the October issue of Pediatrics. In fact, pulse oximetry screening failed to detect any critical congenital heart defects in a large series of newborns over a 12-month period.
