Accepted Articles

Accepted articles will be published online on the $Wiley\ InterScience$ website for Tellus, which can be accessed via http://www.blackwellpublishing.com/tea ($Tellus\ A$) and

http://www.blackwellpublishing.com/teb (Tellus B).

A PDF file prepared by the corresponding author will be published ca. 10 days after the *Tellus* Editorial Office has received the electronic files for the final version of the manuscript and the paper documents related to it. It will be given a DOI number, and thus it can be referenced. The article will keep the DOI number when it has been typeset.

EarlyView

Tellus operates a system called EarlyView, whereby articles are published online ahead of assignment to an issue and publication in print. The *Wiley InterScience* site for EarlyView *Tellus* manuscripts is the same as for Accepted Articles.

Supporting Information

Authors are welcome to submit additional "Supporting Information", such as data sets or additional figures or tables. This material will not be published in the print edition of the journal but it will be viewable via the online edition. Such part of the Supporting Information should be referred to in the text as, for example, "see Appendix S1 in Supporting Information".

Supplementary files are hosted by the Publisher in the format supplied by the author and are not copy-edited by the Publisher.

Color-on-the-web

Color figures not to be printed in color in the journal can be greyscale in the print copy and in color-on-the-web (COW), free of charge.

Review articles

Occasionally the editors of *Tellus* invite authors to prepare review articles. These articles are available free of charge on the publisher's website.

Special issues

Special issues published in Tellus are available free of charge on the publisher's website six months after the issue has been published.

Backfile issues of Tellus 1949–1989 will be available on the Tellus website free of charge in autumn 2009
