Second European Serials Conference

9-11 September 1992

FOLLOWING the success of the First European Serials Conference held in The Netherlands in September 1990, the Second European Serials Conference is now planned for 9-11 September 1992.

As a consequence of the 1990 Conference, a serials interest group has been established in The

Netherlands by a number of librarians, publishers and agents. The group — NVB Serials Group will be joint organiser with the UK Serials Group, of the Second European Serials Conference in 1992.

Confirmation has already been received from many of the proposed speakers, who are drawn from a wide variety of institutions and countries. The programme will include: electronic publishing and electronic

journals, document supply (including papers on CARL, BLDSC and FO DRE), reports on the work of ISDS, IFLA and STM, methods of acquiring serials information in Southern Europe and Eastern Europe, the PICA system and German library networks.

A panel discussion will be devoted to CD ROM Networking drawing on the experiences of librarians in The Netherlands, Switzerland and Sweden.

To provide the opportunity for detailed discussion amongst conference delegates, a number of workshops will focus on serials pricing,

document delivery, serials automation, electronic exchange of information between libraries and the trade and serials cancellations.

Plans are also in hand for optional visits to local libraries, publishers and agents.

The original date planned for the Second European Serials Conference was 28-30 September 1992. It was subsequently discovered that in 1992 the Frankfurt Book Fair commences on 30 September (a surprise to many people who are used to Frankfurt always being in early October).

To avoid a conflict of dates therefore, particularly for publisher delegates, the European Serials Conference has now been rescheduled for 9-11 September.
