## BLACKWELL'S ANNUAL PERIODICAL PRICES FOR 1995



THE 1995 edition of this annual survey of periodical prices is based on a broad selection of journals made by Blackwell's Periodicals Division. It reflects as nearly as possible the annual pattern of periodical purchases in specialised and learned libraries, irrespective of language, price or country of origin. The sample is based on the more important journals in each subject field. The subjects have been chosen to approximate to the subject divisions in special and academic libraries, regardless of individual classification scheme. Previous statistics have appeared in the August 1966–1975, June 1976 and May 1977–1994 issues of the *Record*.

It must be emphasised that this survey is intended only as a guide to trends. It is primarily for the use of libraries in the UK. Figures produced by individual libraries will vary, depending upon the origin of the journals and the emphasis given to particular subject areas.

It should be noted that the 1995 index is based on exchange rates which applied in September 1994, which were very similar to those for September 1993. They therefore had very little impact on this year's index.

On average publishers' price increases in their own currencies were between 9 per cent and 11 per cent. The slightly lower increase in USA titles was due to sterling being marginally stronger against the US dollar than it was the previous year.
