CASE STUDY: ROLE OF VIRECHANA KARMA WITH SHAMANA CHIKITSA IN THE **MANAGEMENT OF EKKUSTHA**

ABSTRACT

Ekkustha (psoriasis) is a non communicable and an auto immune disorder which disturbs the patient at both physical and mental level. It is also a kind of chronic inflammatory disease of the skin which has affected almost 0.44 to 2.8 % population in india.^[1] Ekakustha is considered under ksudra kustha in Ayurveda, which can be compared with psoriasis in Modern medicine. In Ayurveda, the main reason behind the occurrence of this disease is due to the Rakta dusti. Later on this disease disturbs the balance of all three Doshas along with Twaka, Rakta, Mansa and Lasika.^[2] Rakta Dusti occurs due the Nidana (etiology) described in our Samhita like - Virodhi Annapaan^[3] and Past Birth Sins.^[4] It has special features like well demarcated erythematous plaque with silvery scale. As there is no proper cure of psoriasis in Modern medicine so it has become a great challenge to get rid of this disease to a desired level. To treat this disease very effectively, Ayurveda has stated to go for proper Shodhana and Shamana Chikitsa. Shodhana Chikitsa like Vamana, Virechana, Raktamokshana, Nasya are to be prescribed along with various formulations. Method: It is a single case study of a 34-year-old male patient having complaints of silver scaly patches all over the body since last 5 years with generalized weakness. In the case mentioned above, Virechana treatment was given as Shodhana Chikitsa to the patient. For this, Panchtikta Ghrit^[5] was used for Snehan with initial dose of 30ml in first day. Then the dose was increased gradually up to 240ml depending upon the Kostha of the patient. On the 6th day, Samayak Snigdha Lakshan was noticed. After that, two days Sarvanga Abhyangam and Sarvanga Swedan was done. Then on the 9th day, the patient was given Virechana with Danti and Trivritt along with Triphala decoction^[6] according to the Kostha of the patient. After the Samayak Virechan, patient followed the Sansarjana karma for next 7 days. Once the Sansarjana karma was done, Shamana Aousadh was prescribed for 21 days. Result: After taking the proper Shodhana and Shamana Chikitsa for 37 days, there was a marked reduction in the patches on the body. Also, the symptoms like itching and generalized weakness were effectively controlled.

INTRODUCTION

In Ayurveda eighteen types of kustha has been described by Achaaryas. The Kustha is further divided into two types - Mahakustha and Ksudra kustha. Ekakustha comes under the *Ksudrakustha*. The common symptoms described by Achaaryas are Aswedanam, Mahavastu, *Matsyasakloupmum* etc.^[7] which resembles to psoriasis in modern science. The main causative factor of Ekakustha mentioned in our text are Virudh Ahara, Navanna sevan, insulting the Guru, Vegadhaaran specially Chhardi Vega.^[8] These etiological factors Lead to vitiation of Tridoshas, especially Vata and Kapha. In Ayurveda, main line of treatment for this disease is Shaodhana, that is Vamana, Virechana etc. and Shamana Aousadh. This treatment module helps to purify the blood and also acts as an immune modulator. For our case study we have selected Virechana as a Shodhana procedure because Virechana is the best therapy for the treatment of Piittaja and Raktaja Vikara. Shamana Aousadh like Arogyavardhini vati,^[9] Talkeshwar ras,^[10] *Manjisthadi kwatha*,^[11] *Panchtikta ghrit*, were prescribed internally and *Marichyadi* oil^[12] given for local application externally.

Case findings

A 34-year male patient was asymptomatic 5-year before. Gradually patient developed patches on the scalp then spread all over the body with generalized weakness. For this patient had taken many treatments but still patient did not get complete relief. So, patient came to the Devbhoomi medical college of Ayurveda and Hospital, Dehradun in the department of Panchakarma having

Patient has no past history of diabetes, tuberculosis and hypertension etc.

Family history

Patient has not any related family history.

Personal history

Ahara - Excessive Virudh Aahara like paneer, milk with banana

Kostha - Madhyam Mutra pravritti - Samayak Agni - Mandagni Nidra - Samyak Jarana shakti - Heena Abhyavarana shakti - Madhyama Saatmaya - Madhyam Satva - Madhyam Prakriti - Vata kaphaj

Systemic examination - General condition of patient was normal Pulse rate - 72/minute Temperature - Afebrile B.P - 130/80 mmHg Weight - 74 kg

Height - 5.5 ft

Aushadha prayoga

Shamana Chikitsa was given to the patient for 21 days as given below;

- 1) Arogyawardhini Vati 2 TDS
- 2) Talkeshwar ras 125 mg bd
- 3) Panchtikt ghrit 2 tsf bd
- 4) Mahamanjisthadi kwath 40 ml bd
- 5) Mahamarichyadi oil for local application

RESULT

After taking the proper *Shodhana* and *Shamana Chikitsa* for 37 days, there was a marked reduction in the patches on the body. Also, the symptoms like itching and generalized weakness were effectively controlled.

DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION

The main etiological factors mentioned by our Acharyaas for Kustha (Psoriasis) are vitiated Vaata, Kapha & Dushit Rakta. So, to cure this disease, we must normalise the vitiated Vaata, Kapha & purify the Dushit Rakta in the body. By this way we can break the pathological chain. In our study we used those classical medicines which act as blood purifier. In Shamana Chikitsa, we prescribed Arogyawardhini Vati 2 TDS, Talkeshwar ras 125mg bd, Panchtikt ghrit 2 tsf bd, Mahamanjisthadi kwath 40 ml bd, Mahamarichyadi oil for local application. All These formulations are very potent Raktashodhak and Kustha roga nashaka. After Shodhan and Shaman the patient got good result. After finding out the result in this case, it can be concluded

that the above treatment concept can be applied to other *Kustha* patients also.
