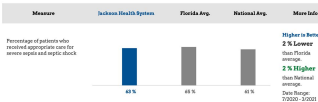


Sepsis

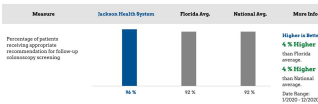
Cataract Surgery Outcome

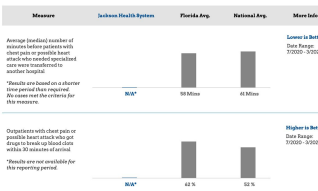
Colonoscopy Follow-Up

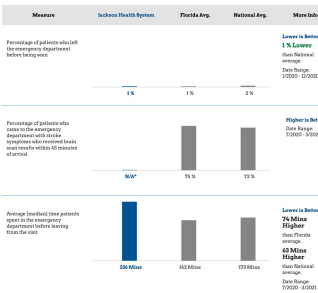
Heart Attack Care

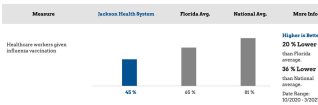

• **Avoiding the risks, costs, and cost of doing imaging when the patient may not need.**
