Every early learning program should have <u>Inclusion</u>

<u>Policies</u> ensure children of all abilities can participate meaningfully in activities.

<u>Families</u> and professionals often collaborate to identify children's needs and appropriate interventions.

<u>Assistive technology</u> can improve the learning and behavior compliance of children with disabilities.

Facilitate independent access to all learning materials and areas.

Adjust toys and activities to children's special needs.

Accommodate therapy services during normal school hours.

Make referrals to programs like <u>Assistive Technology</u> (<u>AT</u>).
