13	Step 1	Each participant gets a piece of paper (or slide) and write their initial ideas at the top of the page.,	Illustration writing	
14	Step 1	They should avoid being too self-critical. Ideas may be preliminary or provocative.	Illustration writing	
15	Step 1 - timing	Give participants about 4 minutes to complete step 1.	Clock icon	
16	Step 2	step 2	Large number	
17	Step 2	Each participant passes their page to the person sitting next to them.	Illustration team work	
18	Step 2	If working remotely, each person moves to the next slide below theirs.	Illustration team work	
19	Step 2	They should write a brief reaction to the ideas they received from their colleague before passing the page around again.	Illustration team work	
20	Step 2 - timing	Give participants about 4 minutes to annotated each page.	Clock icon	
21	Step 3	step 3	Large number	
22	Step 3	After the pages have been reviewed and annotated by all participants, they are returned to the individuals who wrote the initial entry.	Illustration writing	
23	Step 3	Every participant now has a page/slide containing several elaborations of their initial idea from the viewpoint of other participants.	Illustration writing
