TOWN OF CLEARFIELD

Policy Regarding the Replacement of **Mobile Homes or Existing Residences**

- 1. An application shall be submitted to the Town Board to replace an existing mobile home or residence with another dwelling.
- 2. A septic reconnect permit shall be obtained from the Juneau County Zoning Office for the new residence and shall be submitted with the application.
- 3. Once the permit is approved by the Town Board, the new residence can be brought into the Township or constructed on the site, and hooked up to the well and septic. There will be a 10-day transition period to allow time for transferring personal items from the old dwelling to the new dwelling. A mobile home must be removed from the Township prior to the expiration of the 10-day transition time. The old dwelling must be removed or demolished and disposed of within the same timeframe, as only one dwelling is allowed on a parcel of land.
- 4. Failure to remove the mobile home or old dwelling in the time frame outlined will result in a citation being issued for being in violation of Town of Clearfield's Zoning Ordinance. Each day's violation after the 10th day is an individual violation and additional penalties are assessed for the second and subsequent day of violation.
