A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING INTEREST IN HOSTING NUCLEAR OR FUSION ENERGY DEVELOPEMENT IN CASSVILLE, WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, the Village of Cassville has historically played a vital role in Wisconsin's energy landscape, serving as the location for two power generating facilities that have since closed, resulting in economic and employment impacts to the local community; and

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin has recently enacted a new state budget that includes provisions supporting the exploration, development, and advancement of nuclear and fusion energy technologies as part of a long-term, sustainable energy strategy; and

WHEREAS, Cassville offers unique advantages for energy development, including existing transmission infrastructure, proximity to the Mississippi River for cooling and transport access, a skilled regional labor force, and a community that understands and values energy production; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board recognizes the importance of exploring clean, reliable, and future-forward energy solutions that can revitalize local economies, attract investment, and position Cassville as a leader in the next generation of energy development; and

WHEREAS, nuclear fusion energy technologies, offer the potential for high efficiency, low carbon power generation that alliance with pulse state energy, goals, and global environmental commitments

- 1. Support for nuclear fusion energy: the Village of Cassville expresses it support for the continued development of advanced nuclear fusion energy technologies, within the state of Wisconsin.
- Open to hosting future projects: The Village of Cassville affirms its openness to discuss
 discussions with state and federal agencies, utilities, research institutions and private
 sector, developers regarding the siting and development of a nuclear or fusion energy
 facility within or near the village.
- 3. Encouragement of feasibility studies: The Village Board encourages relevant agencies and energy stakeholders to conduct feasibility assessments and community engagement efforts to evaluate Cassville as a potential host site
- 4. Commitment to public engagement: The Village pledges to ensure any exploration of energy development include includes transparency, or public input, and a commitment to the community benefit
