

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO MUNICIPAL SEWER SYSTEM CONNECTIONS AND DRAINAGE AND INSPECTION.

The City Council of Clarks Grove, Minnesota, ordains:

**SECTION I. PROHIBITION AGAINST DRAINAGE.**

No roof, groundwater or surface water drains, including but not limited to sump pumps, shall be connected to the sewer system of the City. Within thirty (30) days upon adoption of this ordinance, any person having a roof or groundwater surface water drain, or sump pump, now connected with the sewer system shall disconnect the same.

**SECTION II. INSPECTION AND RIGHT OF ENTRY.**

The City, or a duly authorized representative of the City, has the right to enter in and upon private property, including buildings and dwelling houses, in or upon which is installed a municipal utility, or connection therewith, at all times reasonable under the circumstances, for the purpose of reading utility meters, for the purpose of inspection and repair of meters or a utility system, or any part thereof, and for the purpose of connecting and disconnecting service.

**SECTION III. PENALTIES.**

Every person who violates a section, subdivision, paragraph or provision of this Ordinance when they perform an act thereby prohibited or declared unlawful, or fails to act when such failure is thereby prohibited or declared unlawful, and upon conviction thereof, ~~shall be punished as for a misdemeanor.~~ *shall be liable to a fine of not to exceed \$10.00 per day*


**SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and upon publication in the official newspaper of the City.
