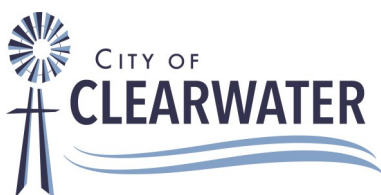


### Construction Updates

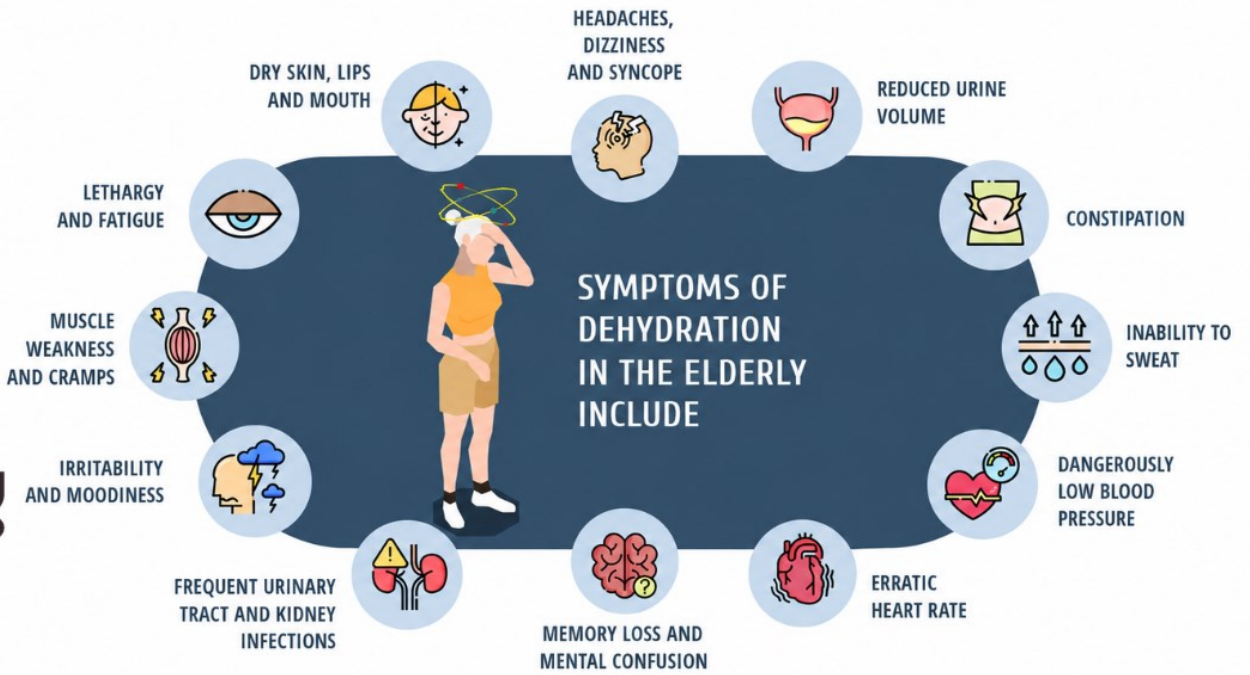
