Amendment to Ordinance No. 3-2006

DESIGNATION OF LOCATION OF STOP SIGNS

The Town Board of Leola, Adams County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

In accordance with Section 349.07(8) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and in the interest of public safety, the Leola Town Board hereby **deletes** the following locations for the installation of stop signs:

- Stop sign on **6th Avenue** traveling **North** at intersection with **Aniwa Lane**
- Stop sign on **6th Avenue** traveling **South** at intersection with **Aniwa Lane**

In accordance with Section 349.07(8) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and in the interest of public safety, the Leola Town Board hereby **designates** the following location for the installation of a stop sign to control traffic on the road over which the Town of Leola has exclusive jurisdiction:

- Stop sign on **Aniwa Lane** traveling **East** at intersection with **6th Avenue**

The above ordinance will go into effect upon posting of appropriate signs, upon publication, and upon notification of the Adams County Sheriff's Department.
