## TOWN OF LEOLA Ordinance No. 1-2015

The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue between County Road D and Aniwa Lane.

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Leola Adams County

The Town Board of the Town of Leola, Adams County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

- A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on the following town highways in the Town of Leola is subject to the following restrictions and limitations: 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue between County Road D and Aniwa Lane.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.\*
- C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$40.00.

This ordinance is effective on [publication or posting or July 30, 2015 (a specific date after the date of publication or posting date, allowing adequate time for erection of signs)].

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
