CLERK'S OFFICE HAPPENINGS

Earlier this spring the City Council approved a new accounting software program for the City. The software program includes; General Ledger, Accounts Payable, Accounts Receivable, Building Permits, Animal Licensing, and Utility Billing. Lots of changes are happening behind the scenes for the clerks, including; Utility Bills, a new online Resident Utility Billing Portal, Accounts payable checks and Receivable Invoices.

The new online Resident Utility Billing Portal will feature a user-friendly format, and give the residents the ability to pay Utility Bills online, look up past bills, set-up and make changes to Auto Pay, by a few clicks of a mouse.

The Animal Licensing and Building Permit Modules will be new for the Clerks, but will allow the clerks to better and more efficiently serve the residents.

The Clerks are looking forward to getting everything up and running over the next couple of months, and appreciate everyone's patience.


