# Dog License Renewal for 2022 - 2023


Deadline December 31, 2021

Dog licenses are required for all dogs over six months old. Please come to City Hall at 420 Main Street to get your two-year license for 2022 - 2023. The cost for spayed/neutered dogs is \$20 for two years; \$40 for dogs not spayed/neutered. A late fee of \$10 is applied after January 1, 2022, with an additional \$10 every month thereafter. The penalty for not having a dog licensed is \$200. Having a dog license also helps the city find a dog's owner if it gets loose. **Please remind people you know with dogs to come renew their licenses.**
