### From City Hall May 2021

Thank you to the Holdingford Lionesses for Holdingford Cares Day. They helped to organize quite a few volunteers that went to numerous locations to help rake, pick up lawns, cemeteries, parking lots and also cleaning up litter along the Wobegon Trail. The trail bridge even received some well-needed sprucing up. Thank you Volunteers and Lionesses!

Our Holdingford Main Street will have its final layer of tar in the next month and will then be finished. The final two street lights are now in place, with audio speakers to be in working order soon. Thank you to the Holdingford Area Chamber of Commerce who spearheaded the Beautifying Main Street project with donations and many hours of planning and implementing the project. With the upcoming events on Main Street, it is really fantastic.

In the past few years, we have seen more and more golf carts, 4 wheelers, ATV Ranger and ATV Razor owners now sharing the streets with cars and trucks and motorcycles. Everyone MUST obey the traffic laws we have. It is for the safety of everyone that only licensed operators and vehicles are allowed on city streets. NO go-carts, dirt bikes, and smaller non-licensed 4 wheelers are allowed on public streets. It is dangerous and illegal for children to be operating these vehicles on city streets.

As you may have seen in prior city minutes, the Council is deciding on whether or not to Repeal City Ordinance No. 115 Regarding the Minnesota State Building Code. This ordinance has been in effect since 2005, and we have had a building inspector taking care of the building permits since that time. The building permit rates have not been raised since 2015. If the Council does repeal the City Ordinance, we are still obligated to have the State Building Code. The Council will need to put other methods in place to administer the Code. A planning and zoning committee would be an option that may be staffed by council members and other residents or a State inspector would be responsible for Holdingford. At the June 14<sup>th</sup>, Council meeting this will be discussed again at a public hearing at 7:00 pm.
