

Lately, the City Council has had several discussions about current City Ordinances. An ordinance is a local law of a municipal corporation (the city), duly enacted by the proper authorities, suggesting general, uniform and permanent rules of conduct relating to the corporate powers of the city.

Ordinances generally govern matters not already covered by state or federal laws. Examples of ordinances would be those related **to noise**, **snow removal**, **pet restrictions**, **building and zoning regulations** to name a few. The Ordinances are rules or guidelines that we have to be as fair to residents and to the city as we can. Some of our ordinances were set quite awhile ago. It is normal for Ordinances to be reviewed and possibly changed for the betterment of the city and it's citizens. Deadline December 31, 2021


Dog licenses are required for all dogs over six months old. Please come to City Hall at 420 Main Street to get your two-year license for 2022 – 2023. The cost for spade/neutered dogs is \$20 for two years; \$40 for dogs not spayed/neutered. A late



fee of \$10 is applied after January 1, 2021. The penalty for not having a dog licensed is \$100.
