**ORDINANCE NO. 156**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 115  
REGARDING THE MINNESOTA STATE BUILDING CODE**

**WHEREAS**, on January 31, 2005, the City Council of the City of Holdingford (the “City”) adopted Ordinance No. 115, entitled “Adopting the Minnesota State Building Code,” and the City has since administered and enforced the Minnesota State Building Code pursuant to its statutory authority to do so; and

**WHEREAS**, although Minnesota Statutes, section 326B.121, subd. 2(a) prohibits certain cities from repealing an ordinance adopting the Minnesota State Building Code, such prohibition does not apply to cities with a population of less than 2,500 according to the last federal census that are located outside of a metropolitan county; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Holdingford has a population of less than 2,500 persons and is not located within a metropolitan county, and therefore it is not precluded from repealing an ordinance adopting the Minnesota State Building Code; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City’s authority to repeal its ordinances, the City desires to repeal Ordinance No. 115 and no longer administer and enforce the Minnesota State Building Code.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Holdingford, Minnesota, does hereby ordain that City of Holdingford Ordinance No. 115, entitled “Adopting the Minnesota State Building Code,” together with any other previously adopted city ordinance that adopts the Minnesota State Building Code, is hereby repealed in its entirety.


This ordinance shall take effect following its adoption and publication in accordance with law.
