Chapter 158. Junkyards

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Village Board of the Village of Almena as § 12.08 of the former Village Code. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 158-1. Permit required.

No person shall keep or maintain a junk shop, junkyard or other place for the deposit and keeping of old iron, copper, rags and bones within the Village limits without first having obtained a permit therefor from the Village Board.

§ 158-2. Application.

Any person desiring to keep such junkyard, shop or other junk area as herein defined shall make written application to the Village Board for a junkyard permit. Such application shall contain the following information:

- A. Name and address of the applicant.
- B. An accurate description of the premises proposed to be granted a permit.
- C. A statement of the nature of the business to be carried on.
- D. An enumeration as nearly as may be made of the articles of merchandise to be handled.

§ 158-3. Issuance.

The Village Board may at its discretion issue a permit to keep, maintain and operate such shop, yard or other place at the location described in such permit for a term of one year from the date thereof, but such permit may be cancelled or revoked by the Board upon giving 30 days' notice of such cancellation or revocation to the holder of such permit.
