February 21<sup>st</sup> – Spring Primary

April 4<sup>th</sup> – Spring General Election

If you are not registered to vote or have recently moved, you can register online at [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov) or print the registration form and mail it to the municipal clerk or register in-person at clerk's office (131 Soo Ave East). Photo ID and proof of residency are required to register to vote.

## DOG LICENSES

Dog licenses are good for one year, January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023. Please bring a copy of the rabies vaccination record.

2023 Pet License Fees:

- \$5 - Neutered / Spayed
- \$10 - Not Neutered / Spayed

Village ordinance requires that pets be leashed and under owner control at all times. Pets running at large will be impounded.
