## ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE

**Dog Poo:** Village ordinance requires pet owners to clean up after their pet. If your dog poo's in your neighbors' yard or in a public area (including the park), clean it up immediately. Please be courteous of others properties as well as Village sidewalks and streets.

**Barking Dogs:** Village ordinance states that it is unlawful to have a dog that habitually barks, "to the great discomfort of the peace and quiet of the neighborhood". Please be considerate of your neighbors who may not have dogs or have small children or work night shift. Excessive or continuous barking or howling will be considered a public nuisance and subject to penalties under the Village ordinance.
