VILLAGE PUBLIC WORKS REMINDERS

- Grass Clippings

 Please do not blow grass clippings into the street as they can be a hazard for pedestrians and bikers. Grass clippings placed in the street often end up in storm sewer catch basins, which can clog drains/pipes or make their way to lakes and streams. There is a compost area located at the end of X avenue for brush, plant material and leaves.

- Flushable?

- Flushing the wrong items can cause clogs, slow drainage, and sewer backups that can be disruptive, costly, and pose health risks. The Village lift stations require additional maintenance due to clogged pumps from non-flushable items.
- o Reminder: Never flush baby wipes, moist wipes, paper towels, medical dressings, pharmaceuticals, sanitary items, fats/oils, plastic, clothing, etc.

- Animal Ordinance

Dogs are required to be licensed. Limit of 2 dogs/cats (or 6 chickens) per household – NO roosters are allowed. Pets are not permitted to run at large and are definitely not allowed to defecate upon another persons' property or be a public nuisance.

Vehicles & Street Parking

- RVs are not allowed to be used for dwelling purposes, except for overnight sleeping, for a maximum of 14 days in any one year
- Truck/Trailer parking is restricted on Village streets to loading and unloading only
- Vehicles may not be parked on streets in same location for more than 48 hours
