Subject: Medway Fire Department Services

The Medway Fire Department has been closely monitoring the COVID-19 situation. Effective June 24th, 2020, The Medway Fire Department will be resuming 26F smoke and carbon monoxide detector inspections, as well as, inspecting permits for underground storage tanks, propane tanks, oil burning equipment, etc. The following procedure will be followed for the inspection process:

• 26F Inspections:

- Submit attached application for 26F inspections via email to <u>Niennon@townofmedway.org</u>; or mail to Medway Fire Department, 44 Milford Street, Medway MA 02053; or call (508)533-3211 to set-up an appointment to drop applications off at the Fire Station.
- o Include contact information on the application, so we may call or email you to schedule the inspection time.
- We ask that only one person be at the home or business at the time of inspection.
- o There is a fee of \$50 per dwelling. Checks are to be made payable to "Town of Medway" and will be collected at the time of your inspection.

Please note: All new home buyers who purchased a home during the period of Governor Baker's executive order deferring 26F inspections from March 20, 2020 – Current, must fill out the attached application. The above procedure will be followed to set up inspections, as per the smoke and carbon monoxide addendum that was signed at closing, and inspections shall occur within 90 days.

- All other permits for storage tanks, oil burning equipment & tanks, propane tanks:
 - Mail permits along with appropriate fees to: Medway Fire Department, 44 Milford Street, Medway MA 02053; or call (508)533-3211 to set-up an appointment to drop permits off at the Fire Station.
 - o Make sure to include homeowners contact information, so we may call to schedule inspections.
 - We ask that only one person be at the home or business at the time of inspection.

The Fire Department is still limiting public access at the Station. All public visits without an appointment and station tours are suspended until further notice. The station will remain open for emergency walk-in calls, as well as, baby safe haven site.
